OUTSIDE OPPORTUNITIES:

The 2018 Ignite LA Fellowships are currently open to Los Angeles County high school **sophomores and juniors.** This opportunity sends students on an **all-expenses-paid Earthwatch expedition** over the summer to conduct hands-on scientific research in the field at a variety of locations throughout the country. The fellowship looks for students with energy, creativity, and a passion to learn, and is not based on academic performance (grades, GPA, test scores, etc.). Applications are due by **December 1**st at earthwatch.org/ignite.

The Diamond Challenge is a global venture concept competition open to all students around the world who have a love for entrepreneurship. It was created in 2012 by the University of Delaware. There are no stipulations to apply to the University of Delaware for those who participate. The competition offers two unique tracks—<u>Business</u> or <u>Social Venture</u>—and both are based on the emerging science of evidence-based entrepreneurship, which combines academic research as well as real-world and industry best practices. The Los Serenos de Point Vicente Junior Docent Program is open to Peninsula, Palos Verdes and Chadwick high school students.
