



2024 VIP RESERVED GRADUATION SEATS ARE AVAILABLE NOW!!!

Row 3 - available at \$200 per seat


Row 4 - available at \$150 per seat

SYNOPSIS:

Screenagers Under The Influence: Addressing Vaping, Drugs, and Alcohol in the Digital Age, the third feature documentary in the Screenagers trilogy, delves into how the tech revolution has reshaped adolescence and its effects on substance use. The film debunks myths and depicts strategies parents and schools can use to encourage healthy decision-making, support teen mental health, set limits, and create healthy home environments. The film also includes many ways young people are using their wisdom and strength to help each other and themselves through this complicated terrain around substance use.

While most documentaries about substance use focus on severe addiction, *Screenagers Under The Influence* fills a pressing need for a film that explores more common scenarios. The film is grounded in teens' current reality of being flooded by images on social media, movies, and TV shows about vaping, drugs, and alcohol.

Like the first two *Screenagers* films, *Screenagers Under The Influence* interweaves cutting-edge science with personal stories to create an informative and entertaining film experience for young people and adults alike. *Screenagers*





Communications Survey







In October 2023, the PVPUSD school board took a substantial step towards updating the 2006 Advanced Placement U.S. History curriculum by approving two textbooks for a pilot that were aligned with the updated 2015 College Board requirements. Subsequently, in January 2024, the board extended this effort by approving a third textbook for inclusion in the ongoing pilot. The ultimate goal is to select one of these textbooks for an official adoption at an upcoming Spring board meeting.

The three textbooks currently undergoing rigorous review are:

- Fraser, James. By the People: A History of the United States, 3rd Edition, Pearson, 2024.
- Davidson, James West, et al. Experience History: Interpreting America's Past, 9th Edition, McGraw-Hill Education, 2019.
- Newly Board Approved 3rd Pilot: Cohen, Lizabeth and Kennedy, David M. The American Pageant, AP® Edition, 17th Edition, Cengage 2020.
