Students may **APPLY to El Camino** from **11:15 am to 11:30 am** as long as *they have their social security number with them...* the application shouldn't take longer than 15-20 minutes. Please come and learn about the Honors Program and opportunities for transfer to UC's, Cal States and private colleges. All students are welcome to attend.

COLLEGE TESTING INFORMATION PRESENTATION will take place on **Wednesday, December 12th, at 8:30 am** in the **MPR**. Freshman, sophomore, and junior parents and students

are welcome to attend! ***Sophomores can also pick up their PreACT test results, and Juniors will receive their PSAT score reports*** after the presentation. DECEMBER 14 - AXA ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP (\$2,500, \$10,000, \$25,000) – seniors only; regional/state/national competition; recognizes those who have demonstrated outstanding achievement in their activities in school, the community or the workplace. DECEMBER 15 - BURGER KING SCHOLARS PROGRAM (Varies) - For high school seniors who are U.S. residents; have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher; plan to enroll at a two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school. James W. McLamore WHOPPER™ Scholarship also available to those with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.3; demonstrate active leadership role in community service, athletics, and/or similar co-curricular activity; demonstrate substantial work experience.
