COLLEGE TESTING INFORMATION PRESENTATION will take place on **Wednesday, December 12th, at 8:30 am** in the MPR. Freshman, sophomore, and junior parents and students are welcome to attend! ***Sophomores can also pick up their PreACT test results, and Juniors will receive their PSAT score reports*** after the presentation. Adam Ingersoll, the co-founder of Compass Education Group, will join us to his share insights on how to help students (and parents!) successfully navigate the testing requirements of college admission. Compass Education Group is a provider of one-on-one tutoring for test preparation.

The ***PALOS VERDES SUNSET ROTARY CLUB*** is **sponsoring a speech contest** for grades 9-12 that will take place on **Tuesday, December 4**. McLamore WHOPPER™ Scholarship also available to those with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.3; demonstrate active leadership role in community service, athletics, and/or similar co-curricular activity; demonstrate substantial work experience.
