COLLEGE TESTING INFORMATION PRESENTATION will take place on **Wednesday, December 12th, at 8:30 am** in the MPR. Freshman, sophomore, and junior parents and students are welcome to attend! ***Sophomores can also pick up their PreACT test results, and Juniors will receive their PSAT score reports*** after the presentation. Adam Ingersoll, the co-founder of Compass Education Group, will join us to his share insights on how to help students (and parents!) successfully navigate the testing requirements of college admission.

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES and DEADLINES:

Please find below a partial list of scholarships that are now posted on NAVIANCE. Many of the scholarships shown are for SENIORS ONLY. However, there are a several open to ALL STUDENTS, grades 9-12. To access more information on these scholarships, please log onto NAVIANCE. Click on the COLLEGES tab and then scroll down to SCHOLARSHIPS and MONEY. Click on SCHOLARSHIP LIST. At this point, select the scholarship of interest. In many cases, you will be directed to a website for the application. In other instances, you may be able to download the application directly from NAVIANCE.

Scholarship Deadlines through January 4, 2018:

DECEMBER 14 - AXA ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP (\$2,500, \$10,000, \$25,000) – seniors only; regional/state/national competition; recognizes those who have demonstrated outstanding achievement in their activities in school, the community or the workplace. APPLY EARLY, only the first 10,000 applications will be accepted. To apply, log onto <https://www.scholarsapply.org/axa-achievement/>

DECEMBER 14 – EDISON SCHOLARS (\$40,000) - for seniors who want to make a difference in the world by studying science, technology, engineering or math (STEM) in college. Requirements for applying include having at least a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale and have financial need. Applications may be found at <https://www.edison.com/home/community/edison-scholars.html>

DECEMBER 15 - BURGER KING SCHOLARS PROGRAM (Varies) - For high school seniors who are U.S. residents; have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher; plan to enroll at a two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school. James W. McLamore WHOPPER™ Scholarship also available to those with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.3; demonstrate active leadership role in community service, athletics, and/or similar co-curricular activity; demonstrate substantial work experience. DECEMBER 31 - AYSO JEFF RICKEL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$2,000) - awarded to a college-bound senior who has played soccer in, and given volunteer service to the American Youth Soccer Organization (AYSO), Region 10. Applicant must demonstrate an understanding of the importance of good sportsmanship. To apply log onto <http://www.ays010.com/>

JANUARY 4– GE REAGAN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP (up to \$40,000) – for seniors only who demonstrate at school, at the workplace, and within the community the attributes of leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship; demonstrate strong academic performance; be citizens of the United States.
