

## **SCHOLARSHIP UPDATE**

March 23, 2018

We are coming to the end of the season for local scholarships. However, there are still several great **LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS** to which to apply. *Several of them are due within the next 10 days.* Take advantage of these wonderful opportunities because, soon, they will be gone! Following the **SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINES** information, you will find a complete list of scholarships, shown alphabetically in various categories that are currently posted on **NAVIANCE**.

To **access more information** on these scholarships, please log onto **NAVIANCE**. Click on the **COLLEGES** tab and then **scroll down to SCHOLARSHIPS and MONEY**. Click on **SCHOLARSHIP LIST**. At this point, click on the scholarship of interest. In many cases, you will be directed to a website for the application. Please make note of the following **SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINES** through **APRIL 2**:

**MARCH 28 – ANDREW SAKURA MEMORIAL** - for male seniors only at PVHS; application includes an essay on one of three prompts relating to friendship. Applications may be downloaded from NAVIANCE.

**MARCH 28 - ROYAL BUSINESS BANK SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM** (\$1,000) – for local high school seniors who plan to attend a U.S. accredited 4–year college or CA/NV community college; must have a min. unweighted GPA of 3.0 and household income at or below CA State low income level; scholarship is open to ALL majors and there is NO ETHNICITY REQUIREMENT. **MARCH 28 - TAIWANESE AMERICAN SCHOLARSHIP FUND** (\$2,500) – students must be a high school senior, a US citizen AND a direct blood descendant of a Taiwanese citizen; plan to attend a university in Fall 2017; have an unweighted GPA of 3.0; have a household income at or below the Federal/State/County Low Income Level. **MARCH 29 - PERRAULT FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP** (varies) – for senior PVHS Varsity soccer player, male or female. Criteria includes leadership and commitment to the sport and academic achievement. Preference will be given to soccer players who have played defensive positions. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.

**MARCH 29 - PVHS SCIENCE NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY** (\$500) – SNHS will be offering five \$500 scholarships for seniors who are members in good standing. To apply, log onto <https://pvsnhs.weebly.com/>. Applications may also be downloaded from Naviance. Completed applications need to be returned to Mrs. Maemoto or Mrs. Kuhn.

**MARCH 29 (extended) - PV JUNIOR WOMEN'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP** (varies) - seniors only; awarded primarily on financial need with a secondary emphasis on academic achievement, community service and extracurricular activities. **MARCH 29 – PVP LION'S CLUB** - seniors only; one scholarship given to a student majoring in the arts; remaining scholarships given to students pursuing other endeavors; min GPA of 3.0, service, leadership, financial need considered. Applications may be downloaded from NAVIANCE.

**MARCH 29 (extended) – SEAN HEFFERNAN MEMORIAL** - graduating senior who shows academic achievement, community service; must include original artwork (includes photography, poem, writing, sculpture, etc.) and an essay on caring. Applications may be downloaded from NAVIANCE.

**MARCH 29 - SILVER SPUR** (\$1,000) - for Silver Spur alums; community service and extracurricular activities considered; short essay. Applications may be downloaded from NAVIANCE.

**MARCH 31 - JACL ERNEST TSUJIMOTO** (\$2,000) – seniors only; must be of Japanese-American ancestry and planning to pursue an undergraduate/graduate degree in the STEM fields: Science, Technology Engineering and Math. **ANDREW SAKURA MEMORIAL** (\$1,000) - for male seniors only at PVHS; application includes an essay on one of three prompts relating to friendship. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance. **DEADLINE: MARCH 28, 2018**

**NRT "SHARE YOUR MOVING STORY" SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM** (\$2,000) – Open to high school juniors and seniors. Applicants must submit an original essay of 1,000 words or less exploring how the moving process has personally affected him/her. **PVP REPUBLICAN WOMEN, FEDERATED SCHOLARSHIP** – for graduating high school seniors students who subscribe to a Conservative/Republican philosophy; must be a U.S. Citizen; prepare an essay of 500-1000 words on the topic of "What the U.S. Constitution Means to Me". **DEADLINE: APRIL 9, 2018**

**PVP LION'S CLUB** (\$500 - \$1000) – seniors only; consideration will be given to academic achievement (min. GPA of 3.0), service to others, leadership, financial need and a strong desire/plan for further education/professional focus. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance. **DEADLINE: MARCH 29, 2018**

**ROYAL BUSINESS BANK SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM** (\$1,000) – for local high school seniors who plan to attend a U.S. accredited 4-year college or CA/NV community college; must have a min. unweighted GPA of 3.0 and household income at or below CA State low income level; scholarship is open to ALL majors and there is NO ETHNICITY REQUIREMENT. ## OTHER

Students (grades 9-12) submit their original art piece to their representative and a panel of art professionals select the winning entry. Artwork must be two dimensional and can be no larger than 26" x 26" x 4", including frame. **HARBOR LIGHTS ESCROW ASB/CHEER SCHOLARSHIP** (varies) – for seniors who have been enrolled at PVHS for two years prior to graduation; applicant must be an ASB student or a member of the Sea Kings Cheer Squad. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance. **DEADLINE: APRIL 12, 2018**

**HARBOR LIGHTS ESCROW BASEBALL SCHOLARSHIP** (varies) - for seniors who have been enrolled at PVHS for two years prior to graduation; applicant must be an active player on the PVHS baseball team and continue to play baseball at a college or university. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance. **DEADLINE: APRIL 12, 2018**

**HARBOR LIGHTS ESCROW GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP** (varies) – for seniors who have been enrolled at PVHS for two years prior to graduation; applicant must be ethical, diligent and dependable; students who have contributed to school and community, or worked, or have special talents. Students do not have to be at the top of the class; hard work and perseverance are important. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance. **DEADLINE: APRIL 12, 2018**

**PERRAULT FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP** (varies) – for senior PVHS Varsity soccer player, male or female. Criteria includes leadership and commitment to the sport and academic achievement. Preference will be given to soccer players who have played defensive positions. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance. **DEADLINE: MARCH 29, 2018**
