Our goal is to making writing fun for both the reporters and the volunteers. In addition to our afterschool newspaper clubs, we have a number of fun summer programs at the Wilmington **Boys & Girls Club**, the **Boys & Girls Club** of Port of LA, and Richstone Family Center. Students who volunteer 25 hours or more in a year, including at least three afterschool newspaper club mentorings, can apply for a position on our student board. We are a youth-led, all-volunteer organization, so our student board runs all of our afterschool newspaper club mentorings and our summer sessions.
