**FINANCIAL AID NIGHT: PAYING FOR COLLEGE** is **Wednesday, September 26, 2018 at 6:30 pm in the MPR at PVHS**. This presentation will cover four main topics relating to financial aid for college: the types of financial aid that are available, how schools determine eligibility for financial aid, how to apply for financial aid, and how to find merit scholarships. This event is targeted for parents of juniors/seniors but all are welcome. Jessica Medina, Assistant Director for the Financial Aid Office at USC, will be presenting this important information.

- **Official** high school transcript
- **Official** SAT or ACT scores (SAT school code: 7199 / ACT school code: 7272)
- One-page essay explaining why you wish to attend a Service Academy
- Resume of extracurricular activities
- Current photo
- A completed application form

**The *2019 Ignite LA Fellowships* are currently open to Los Angeles County high school sophomores and juniors.** This opportunity sends students on an ***all-expenses-paid Earthwatch expedition*** over the summer to conduct hands-on scientific research in the field at a variety of locations throughout the country. The fellowship looks for students with energy, creativity, and a passion to learn, and is not based on academic performance (grades, GPA, test scores, etc.). ***Student Pollworker Program:*** The Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk would like to encourage students of 16 years of age or older to **volunteer as a student pollworker** for the upcoming **November 6, 2018 Statewide Direct Primary Election**. Students are expected to be present at the polling place **from 6 a.m. to approximately 9:30 p.m.** Students are assigned to a precinct in close proximity to their home or school. All students who are placed are required to attend a training session prior to Election Day. In addition to gaining an invaluable learning experience about the

democratic process, **students receive \$100 for serving on Election Day and an additional \$40 bonus for attending a training class.**

Any high school student that meets the following requirements may apply:

- Must be a U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident **AND** 16 years of age
- Must be attending a public/private secondary institution
- Must be in good academic standing with a GPA of 2.5 or greater
- Must have teacher and parental consent.

In order to be considered for this program, **students must complete the Student Pollworker Applications which are available in the College and Career Center. All applications must be returned to Mrs. Hoffman in the College and Career Center no later than Friday, September 21.** Please note that the **program will ONLY accept 20 students from PVHS.**

### **SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES and DEADLINES:**

Please find below a partial list of scholarships that are now posted on NAVIANCE. Many of the scholarships shown are for SENIORS ONLY. However, there are a several open to ALL STUDENTS, grades 9-12. To access more information on these scholarships, please log onto NAVIANCE. Click on the COLLEGES tab and then scroll down to SCHOLARSHIPS and MONEY. Click on SCHOLARSHIP LIST. At this point, select the scholarship of interest. In many cases, you will be directed to a website for the application. In other instances, you may be able to download the application directly from NAVIANCE.

### **Scholarship Deadlines through December 14, 2018**

- **OCTOBER 31 - COCA COLA SCHOLARS** (\$20,000) – this is an achievement-based scholarship awarded to graduating high school seniors. Students are recognized for their capacity to lead and serve, as well as their commitment to making a significant impact on their schools and communities. 150 Coca-Cola Scholars are selected each year to receive this \$20,000 scholarship. Students who will be graduating in the 2018-2019 academic school year may apply at <https://webportalapp.com/sp/login/ccsf> through Wednesday, October 31, 2018, at 5:00 p.m. Eastern.
- **NOVEMBER 1 - JUNIOR AMERICAN CITIZEN CREATIVE EXPRESSION CONTEST** (Varies) - grade 9-12; several categories from which to choose including art, creative writing, photography and community service. The theme for 2018/2019 is “*The 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Lunar landing – America’s Great Move Forward in Exploration and Technology*”. Students are welcome to think about people, events, places or traditions influenced by the lunar landing. Further information/applications may be downloaded from NAVIANCE.
- **NOVEMBER 15 - ELKS CLUB MVS FOUNDATION** (up to \$50,000) – seniors only; local/district/state/national competition; applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, community service, and financial need.
