Please make note of the following **DEADLINES** through February 2:

JANUARY 23 - COOLIDGE SCHOLARSHIP (full-ride for college) – **JUNIORS ONLY** who plan to enroll in college in the fall 2020. It can be used by recipients at any accredited U.S. college or university. The main criterion is academic merit. Additionally, it seeks those who are interested in public policy; demonstrate an awareness of the values of President Coolidge; display a sense of service and care for the well-being of others. To qualify you must be a high school junior who will graduate in the Class of 2020; be committed to pursuing a career in journalism; demonstrate qualities of a “free spirit”. FEBRUARY 1 - ELK’S LEGACY AWARD (\$4,000) – seniors only; any child/grandchild of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2016 is eligible to apply. FEBRUARY 2 - DELTA SIGMA THETA SORORITY, INC.
