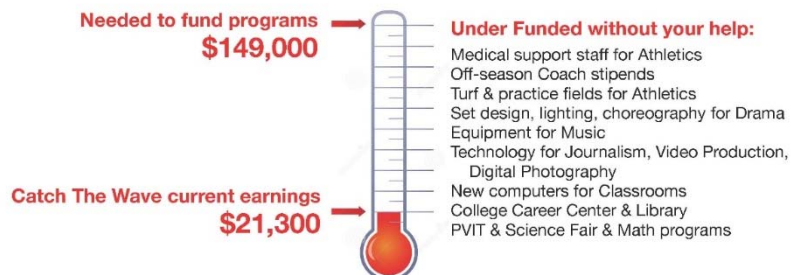

OUTSIDE OPPORTUNITIES

The EVE and GENE BLACK SUMMER MEDICAL CAREER PROGRAM is an opportunity best described as a **medical mentor program**. Students work under the supervision of a health

care educator shadowing various medical professionals (nurse, nutritionist, pharmacist, lab technician, and/or physician) who together provide a range of patient care and services. The program accepts applications from high school students who are **current 11th and 12th graders AND born ON or BEFORE 4/1/2003**. The 2019 program has 2, 3, and 4 week programs. JANUARY 31 - PVP ROTARY CLUB SPEECH CONTEST (\$200 - \$1,000) - grades 9-12; students will present their speech on February 8 at the Rotary Club Meeting. Speech Topic: *“Be the Inspiration”*, the Rotary Motto this year. Completed application is due prior to speech. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.

FEBRUARY 1 - AL NEUHARTH FREE SPIRIT SCHOLARSHIP – JUNIORS ONLY are encouraged to apply for the 2019, all expense-paid, conference at the Newseum in Washington, D.C. To qualify you must be a high school junior who will graduate in the Class of 2020; be committed to pursuing a career in journalism; demonstrate qualities of a “free spirit”. FEBRUARY 1 - COX CARES (up to \$5,000) - seniors only; will enroll in a two or four year college within the U.S.; minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0; demonstrated commitment to volunteer service; demonstrated financial need. To apply, log onto www.coxcharitiesca.org

FEBRUARY 1 - ELK'S LEGACY AWARD (\$4,000) – seniors only; any child/grandchild of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2016 is eligible to apply. Candidates who qualify are judged on knowledge, charity, community service and integrity. To apply, log onto <https://www.elks.org/scholars/scholarships/legacy.cfm>

FEBRUARY 2 - DELTA SIGMA THETA SORORITY, INC. LOS ANGELES CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP (varies) - seniors only; must be of African-American ancestry; have at least at 3.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale and an ACT/SAT score in the 90th percentile; demonstrate extracurricular activity/leadership; show financial need. FEBRUARY 5 - SANDPIPERS SCHOLARSHIP (varies) - seniors only; minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0; demonstrate financial need; actively involved in community service; scholarship RENEWABLE for each year in college. To apply, log onto <http://app.smarterselect.com/programs/55505-Sandpipers>

FEBRUARY 15 - LOS ANGELES CLIPPERS (\$4,000) - seniors only; regional competition; judged on academic achievement, extracurricular activities, community activities and a 300-word essay on the topic, "Why College is Important to Me".
