### ***Scholarship Deadlines through mid-January 2020***

**DECEMBER 15 - AXA ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP** (\$2,500, \$10,000, \$25,000) – seniors only; regional/state/national competition; recognizes those who have demonstrated outstanding achievement in their activities in school, the community or the workplace. APPLY EARLY, only the first 10,000 applications will be accepted. To apply, log onto <https://www.scholarsapply.org/axa-achievement/>.

**DECEMBER 15 - BURGER KING SCHOLARS PROGRAM** (Varies) - For high school seniors who are U.S. residents; have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher; plan to enroll at a two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school. James W. McLamore WHOPPER™ Scholarship also available to those with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.3; demonstrate active leadership role in community service, athletics, and/or similar co-curricular activity; demonstrate substantial work experience. Only the first 50,000 submitted will be processed. To apply, log onto <https://www.scholarsapply.org/burgerkingscholars/>.

**DECEMBER 16 – EDISON SCHOLARS** (\$40,000) - for seniors who want to make a difference in the world by studying science, technology, engineering or math (STEM) in college. Requirements for applying include having at least a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale and have financial need. Applications may be found at <https://www.edison.com/home/community/edison-scholars.html>.

**JANUARY 3 – GE REAGAN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP** (up to \$40,000) – for seniors only who demonstrate at school, at the workplace, and within the community the attributes of leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship; demonstrate strong academic performance; be citizens of the United States. ONLY first 25,000 applications accepted. To apply log onto <https://www.reaganfoundation.org/education/scholarship-programs/ge-reagan-foundation-scholarship-program/>.

**JANUARY 16 - COOLIDGE SCHOLARSHIP** (full-ride for college) – **JUNIORS ONLY** who plan to enroll in college in the fall 2021. It can be used by recipients at any accredited U.S. college or university. The main criterion is academic merit. Additionally, it seeks those who are interested in public policy; demonstrate an awareness of the values of President Coolidge; display a sense of service and care for the well-being of others. **JANUARY 31 - ELK'S LEGACY AWARD** (\$4,000) – seniors only; any child/grandchild of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2017 is eligible to apply. Candidates who qualify are judged on knowledge, charity, community service and integrity. To apply, log onto
