• **DECEMBER 15 - AXA ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP** (\$2,500, \$10,000, \$25,000) – seniors only; regional/state/national competition; recognizes those who have demonstrated outstanding achievement in their activities in school, the

- **DECEMBER 15 BURGER KING SCHOLARS PROGRAM** (Varies) For high school seniors who are U.S. residents; have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher; plan to enroll at a two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school. James W. McLamore WHOPPER™ Scholarship also available to those with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.3; demonstrate active leadership role in community service, athletics, and/or similar co-curricular activity; demonstrate substantial work experience. - DECEMBER 16 EDISON SCHOLARS (\$40,000) for seniors who want to make a difference in the world by studying science, technology, engineering or math (STEM) in college.

- JANUARY 3 GE REAGAN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP (up to \$40,000)
 for seniors only who demonstrate at school, at the workplace, and within the community the attributes of leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship; demonstrate strong academic performance; be citizens of the United States. - JANUARY 16 COOLIDGE SCHOLARSHIP (full-ride for college) JUNIORS ONLY who plan to enroll in college in the fall 2021. It can be used by recipients at any accredited U.S. college or university. The main criterion is academic merit. Additionally, it seeks those who are interested in public policy; demonstrate an awareness of the values of President Coolidge; display a sense of service and care for the well-being of others. - · JANUARY 31 *ELK'S LEGACY AWARD* (\$4,000) seniors only; any child/grandchild of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2017 is eligible to apply.
