· **DECEMBER 31 - AYSO JEFF RICKEL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** (\$2,000) - awarded to a college-bound senior who has played soccer in, and given volunteer service to the American Youth Soccer Organization (AYSO), Region 10. · **JANUARY 3 – GE REAGAN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP** (up to \$40,000) – for seniors only who demonstrate at school, at the workplace, and within the community the attributes of leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship; demonstrate strong academic performance; be citizens of the United States. · **JANUARY 16 - COOLIDGE SCHOLARSHIP** (full-ride for college) – **JUNIORS ONLY** who plan to enroll in college in the fall 2021. It can be used by recipients at any accredited U.S. college or university. The main criterion is academic merit. Additionally, it seeks those who are interested in public policy; demonstrate an awareness of the values of President Coolidge; display a sense of

· **JANUARY 31 - ELK'S LEGACY AWARD** (\$4,000) – seniors only; any child/grandchild of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2017 is eligible to apply.
