OUTSIDE OPPORTUNITIES

2019 LA BioMed SUMMER FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM provides LA County **graduating high school seniors and high school juniors** the opportunity to work in a biomedical research environment. Selected students will spend eight weeks assisting their assigned mentors, who are accomplished medical scientists involved in cutting edge biomedical research. **Fellowships begin**

on Monday, June 17th, 2019 and continue through Friday, August 9th, 2019. Students will work full time and receive a total stipend of \$2,200. Students will be selected on the basis of merit. GIRLS WHO CODE is a free introductory summer immersion computer science program for girls going into their junior or senior year of high school. During a seven week program, participants learn about computer science, gain exposure to tech jobs, and join a national sisterhood of girls who are using computer science to become change-makers. This program is hosted at major tech companies across the United States, so girls get a firsthand look at what it's like to work in computing and are able to envision their own futures in this field. - ✓ **MARCH 13 - JACK BAGDASAR** (\$500) – awarded to a senior who demonstrates the ability and desire to be an elementary school teacher. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance
- ✓ **MARCH 15 - CABRILLO CIVIC CLUBS OF CA** (\$500) -seniors only; must be of Portuguese descent; minimum weighted GPA of 3.5; participated in three extracurricular activities. To apply log onto <http://www.cabrillocivicclubs.org/scholarship.asp>. Applications may also be downloaded from Naviance.

- ✓ **MARCH 15 - ELK'S STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES SCHOLARSHIP** (\$1,000-\$3,000) - to be eligible to apply, individuals must be a U.S. citizen; be a resident of CA or HI; have a physical, neurological, visual, hearing and/or speech/language impairment; and be a senior in high school. Funds are to be used for undergraduate work. Selection criteria is based on the following: severity of disability, financial need, GPA, seriousness of purpose and depth of character. - ✓ **MARCH 15 - ITALIAN CATHOLIC FEDERATION** (up to \$2,500) - seniors only; must be of Italian ancestry and also Roman Catholic; minimum unweighted GPA of 3.2; participation in extracurricular activities; financial need. To apply log onto www.icf.org. Applications may also be downloaded from Naviance.
- ✓ **MARCH 15 - PANHELLENIC ALUMNAE SOUTH BAY ASSOCIATION** (\$1,000) - for female seniors only who will be attending a 4 year college or university where sororities are established; must demonstrate academic excellence, demonstrate character, participation in school/community, and financial need. To apply log onto www.SouthBayPanhellenic.com. Applications may also be downloaded from Naviance.
- ✓ **MARCH 15 - PEF SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM** (\$1,500) –seniors only; must be currently enrolled in the PVPUSD and maintained enrollment for two years prior to graduation; need to write a maximum 500 word essay on the following topic "How has PEF funding enhanced students' educational experience?"
