Following the **SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINES** information, you will find a complete list of scholarships, shown alphabetically in various categories, which are currently posted on **NAVIANCE**. **Please consider applying for these scholarships because, soon, they will be gone.**

Please make note of the following **DEADLINES** through **APRIL 19**:

MARCH 31 - JACL ERNEST TSUJIMOTO (\$2,000) – seniors only; must be of Japanese-American ancestry and planning to pursue an undergraduate/graduate degree in the STEM fields: Science, Technology Engineering and Math. To apply, log onto http://www.southbayjacl.org/scholarship_sb.html. Applications may also be downloaded from Naviance

MARCH 31 - JACL GARDENA VALLEY (\$500 - \$1,000) – seniors only; must be of Japanese-American ancestry; min 2.5 GPA; emphasis on Japanese American community involvement and volunteerism. To apply, log onto http://www.southbayjacl.org/scholarship_sb.html. Applications may also be downloaded from Naviance.

MARCH 31 - JACL JANICE KOBATA ZOEGER MEMORIAL (\$500 - \$1,000) - seniors only, must be of Japanese-American ancestry and planning to pursue a degree in any field relating to biological sciences, foreign or ancient language or business. To apply, log onto http://www.southbayjacl.org/scholarship_sb.html. Applications may also be downloaded from Naviance.

MARCH 31 - JACL KIICHI EGASHIRA MEMORIAL (\$500 - \$2,000) - seniors only; must be of Japanese-American ancestry and planning to pursue a degree in physical or biological sciences, engineering or mathematics. To apply, log onto http://www.southbayjacl.org/scholarship_sb.html. Applications may also be downloaded from Naviance.

APRIL 1 - HARRY BRANDEL (varies) - seniors only; must be a resident of PVE and attending college in the fall 2017 with a major of architecture, landscape architecture, historic preservation, civil engineering, land use planning or the fine arts. APRIL 8 - PVP REPUBLICAN WOMEN, FEDERATED SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000) – for graduating high school seniors who subscribe to a Conservative/Republican philosophy; must be a U.S. Citizen; prepare an essay of 500-1000 words on the topic of “What the U.S. Constitution Means to Me”.

APRIL 9 - PVP ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS (varies) – for seniors only who attend PVPUSD high schools; students need to attend 2 or 4-year colleges in fall 2018; have contributed to school and community; demonstrate financial need. Applications may be downloaded from NAVIANCE.

APRIL 10 - SILVER SPUR (\$1,000) - for Silver Spur alums; community service and extracurricular activities considered; short essay. Applications may be downloaded from NAVIANCE.

APRIL 12 - CHUCK CHAMBERS/RUSS URBAN (\$500) - seniors only; application and essay on service you have done in school or community. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.

APRIL 12 - CORNERSTONE ALUMNAE (\$500) - honors an outstanding high school senior who is also a Cornerstone graduate. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.

APRIL 18 - SKECHERS FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000 - \$5,000) – for high school seniors planning to enroll in an accredited 2 or 4 year college or vocational school, min. unweighted GPA of 3.0; there are four different scholarships to which to apply: financial need, academic excellence, athletic performance, leadership. **Applications must be submitted by April 18 or within the first 300 applications submitted, whichever occurs first.** To apply, log onto <https://www.scholarsapply.org/skechers/> . **DEADLINE: APRIL 18, 2019**

APRIL 19 (extended) - SUSAN PAVELKA SCHOLARSHIP FOR JOURNALISTIC EXCELLENCE (\$500) – for a college-bound senior who has participated and excelled in Palos Verdes High School journalism. Candidates are eligible to apply after fulfilling a minimum of two consecutive years as a leader/writer in one or more of these journalism programs: yearbook, literary magazine, newspaper, podcast or broadcast news. Applicants are judged based on leadership, writing and character along with two written entries publications/broadcasts. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.

CORNERSTONE ALUMNAE (\$500) - honors an outstanding high school senior who is also a Cornerstone graduate. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance. **DEADLINE: APRIL 12, 2019**

JACK MATTHEWS SCHOLARSHIP (\$2,000) - for students who plan to attend a college or vocational school in the fall of 2019. Students must be a member of the LA Federal Credit Union and have a minimum 2.50 GPA, involvement in extracurricular activities/community service in order to apply. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance. **DEADLINE: APRIL 30, 2019**

SILVER SPUR (\$1,000) - for Silver Spur alums; community service and extracurricular activities considered; short essay. Applications may be downloaded from NAVIANCE. **DEADLINE: APRIL 10, 2019**

SKECHERS FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000 - \$5,000) – for high school seniors planning to enroll in an accredited 2 or 4 year college or vocational school, min. unweighted GPA of 3.0; there are four different scholarships to which to apply: financial need, academic excellence, athletic performance, leadership. **Applications must be submitted by April 18 or within the first 300 applications submitted, whichever occurs first.** To apply, log onto <https://www.scholarsapply.org/skechers/>. **DEADLINE: APRIL 18, 2019**

SUSAN PAVELKA SCHOLARSHIP FOR JOURNALISTIC EXCELLENCE (\$500) – for a college-bound senior who has participated and excelled in Palos Verdes High School journalism. Candidates are eligible to apply after fulfilling a minimum of two consecutive years as a leader/writer in one or more of these journalism programs: yearbook, literary magazine, newspaper, podcast or broadcast news.
