APRIL 9 - **PVP ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS** (varies) — for seniors only who attend PVPUSD high schools; students need to attend 2 or 4-year colleges in fall 2018; have contributed to school and community; demonstrate financial need. Applications may be downloaded from NAVIANCE.

APRIL 10 - *SILVER SPUR* (\$1,000) - for Silver Spur alums; community service and extracurricular activities considered; short essay. Applications may be downloaded from NAVIANCE.

APRIL 12 - *CHUCK CHAMBERS/RUSS URBAN* (\$500) - seniors only; application and essay on service you have done in school or community. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.

APRIL 12 - **CORNERSTONE ALUMNAE** (\$500) - honors an outstanding high school senior who is also a Cornerstone graduate. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
