Link Crew is a high school transition program that welcomes freshmen and makes them feel comfortable throughout the first year of their high school experience. Built on the belief that students can help students succeed, Link Crew trains members of the junior and senior classes to be Link Leaders. Seniors - Are you playing a sport in college? If so we need to send a FINAL transcript to the NCAA Clearing House upon your graduation. Please get a FINAL NCAA Transcript form in the Counseling Office and turn it into Mrs Nelson.

Current Juniors - Are you wanting to play sports in college? If so, you need to make sure you are registered with the NCAA. Once you are registered fill out a NCAA Transcript form to have your transcript sent at the end of your Jr Year. Questions - see Mrs Nelson in the Counseling Office.

Attention Seniors: You are required to send a final transcript to the college you are attending in the fall. The final transcript order form is available at the front of the counseling office. Please check to make sure your college will accept electronic documents via your Naviance account. If you are attending a college that does not accept electronic documents you MUST provide your counselor with a stamped and addressed envelope to mail the transcript. If you are unsure follow the directions or stop by and see your counselor. Final transcripts must be ordered by graduation.
