




#### TRITON YEARBOOK

Scholarship Deadlines through November 5, 2019

OCTOBER 31 - COCA COLA SCHOLARS (\$20,000) — this is an achievement-based scholarship awarded to graduating high school seniors. Students are recognized for their capacity to lead and serve, as well as their commitment to making a significant impact on their schools and communities. 150 Coca-Cola Scholars are selected each year to receive this \$20,000 scholarship. OCTOBER 31 - VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS VOICE OF DEMOCRACY SPEECH CONTEST (up to \$30,000) - this audio essay contest provides students in grades 9 - 12 the unique opportunity to express themselves in regards to a democratic and patriotic-themed 3-5 minute recorded essay.
