

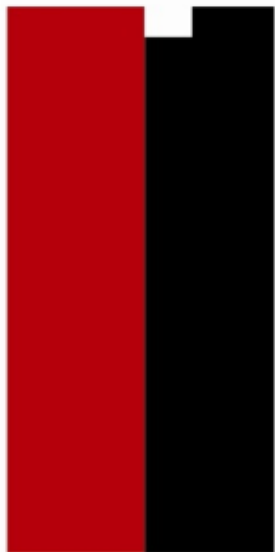

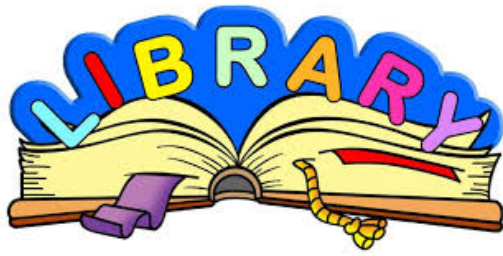

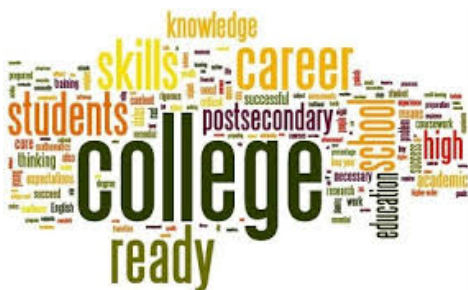

COLLEGE AND CAREER CENTER NEWS:

FAFSA WORKSHOP is Thursday, **October 3, 2019** at 6:00 pm in the MPR at PVHS. Seniors need to submit the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) to the colleges to which they are applying in order to determine if they are eligible for any financial aid awards. Jessica Medina of the University of Southern California, will be going through the FAFSA line by line and answering ANY questions that you may have. This program is targeted for parents of seniors. However, it may also be helpful for parents of juniors to attend in order to gain an understanding of the information needed to fill out this form next year!

Applications for the **2020 MILITARY ACADEMY NOMINATION CYLCLE** are currently be accepted by Congressman Ted Lieu's office. All applications for nomination must be received by 5:00 pm on **October 18, 2019**. Interviews will be held on **November 2, 2019**. To request a Military Academy Nomination from their office, please submit a complete application, found at <https://lieu.house.gov/services/military-academy-nominations> that includes:

- **3 letters of recommendation (at least 2 academic)**
- **Official high school transcript**
- **Official SAT or ACT scores (SAT school code: 7199 / ACT school code: 7272)**
- **One-page essay explaining why you wish to attend a Service Academy**
- **Resume of extracurricular activities**
- **Current photo**
- **A completed application form**

COLLEGE VISITS NEXT WEEK:

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING COLLEGE VISITS in 2019-20:
Students are required to **REGISTER TO ATTEND** a college visit at least 48 hours prior to the visit. Students sign up under the "Colleges" tab on Naviance. Students must obtain prior permission from their teacher to attend the visit. Please download the CCC College Visit Permission Slip which can be found on the PVHS website under College and Career Center.

OUTSIDE OPPORTUNITIES:

The Congressional App Challenge is a public effort to encourage kids to learn how to code, through district-wide competitions. All middle and high school students that either attend or reside in CA-33 are eligible to participate. Students may register as individuals or as teams of up to four. To register, please go to www.CongressionalAppChallenge.us. The deadline for students to submit their app online is Friday, **November 1, 2019**.

The 2020 Ignite LA Fellowships are currently open to Los Angeles County high school sophomores and juniors. This opportunity sends students on an all-expenses-paid Earthwatch expedition over the summer to conduct hands-on scientific research in the field at a variety of locations throughout the country. The fellowship looks for students with energy, creativity, and a passion to learn, and is not based on academic performance. Applications are due by **December 4**. SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES and DEADLINES:

Please find below a partial list of scholarships that are now posted on NAVIANCE. Many of the scholarships shown are for SENIORS ONLY. However, there are a several open to ALL STUDENTS, grades 9-12. To access more information on these scholarships, please log onto NAVIANCE. Click on the COLLEGES tab and then scroll down to SCHOLARSHIPS and MONEY. Click on SCHOLARSHIP LIST. At this point, select the scholarship of interest. In many cases, you will be directed to a website for the application. In other instances, you may be able to download the application directly from NAVIANCE.

Scholarship Deadlines through **November 5, 2019**

OCTOBER 31 - COCA COLA SCHOLARS (\$20,000) – this is an achievement-based scholarship awarded to graduating high school seniors. Students are recognized for their capacity to lead and serve, as well as their commitment to making a significant impact on their schools and communities. 150 Coca-Cola Scholars are selected each year to receive this \$20,000 scholarship. Students who will be graduating in the 2019-2020 academic school year may apply at <https://webportalapp.com/sp/login/ccsf> through Wednesday, **October 31, 2019**.

OCTOBER 31 - VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS VOICE OF DEMOCRACY SPEECH CONTEST (up to \$30,000) - this audio essay contest provides students in grades 9 - 12 the unique opportunity to express themselves in regards to a democratic and patriotic-themed 3-5 minute recorded essay. This year's theme is "What Makes America Great". Entry forms are available on line at www.vfw.org.

NOVEMBER 5 - ELKS CLUB MVS FOUNDATION (up to \$50,000) – seniors only; local/district/state/national competition; applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, community service, and financial need.
