Due to the limited capacity of our gymnasium and high demand for tickets, we have developed newprocedures to obtaining tickets to the PV versus Peninsula basketball game. This system uses the lottery method to maximize opportunities

for students to attend the game. We look forward to the use of this system to be fair to all students while prioritizing seniors.

Tuesday, **January 21** is the first Bay League match-up between our PV Sea Kings basketball teams and our crosstown rivals, Peninsula Panthers. The games will be played at Palos Verdes High, with the girls starting at 6:00pm, followed by the boys at 7:30pm..
