



recommend checking your application portal or calling the admissions office. Counselors will be sending mid year reports in early February once first semester grades have posted to transcripts. If you have any questions please see your counselor.




The National Honor Society Induction Banquet is February 3, 2020 at

In many cases, you will be directed to a website for the application. In other instances, you may be able to download the application directly from NAVIANCE.
