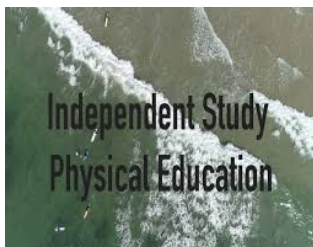

In many cases, you will be directed to a website for the application. In other instances, you may be able to download the application directly from NAVIANCE.
