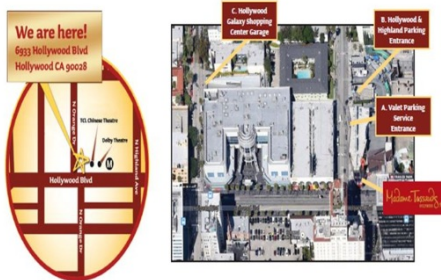

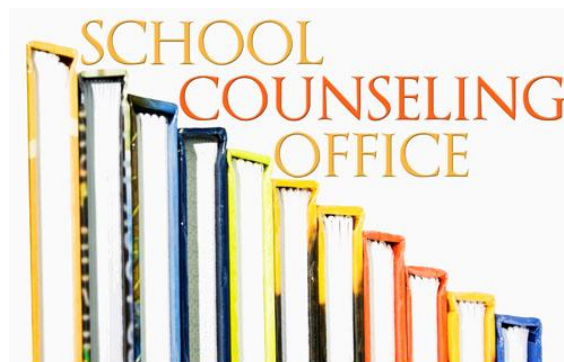


Senior Sea Kings,

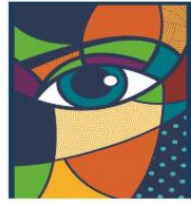
