In order to be considered for the Cal Grant Awards, seniors must also submit the FAFSA. If you have NOT filed the FAFSA, please do so before the deadline posted by the college/university to which you applied. SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES and DEADLINES:

As scholarships become available, they will be posted on NAVIANCE. To access more information on these scholarships, please log onto NAVIANCE. Click on the COLLEGES tab and then scroll down to SCHOLARSHIPS and MONEY. Click on SCHOLARSHIP LIST. At this point, select the scholarship of interest. In many cases, you will be directed to a website for the application. In other instances, you may be able to download the application directly from NAVIANCE. Here are a few with upcoming deadlines:

- DECEMBER 14 EDISON SCHOLARS (\$40,000) for seniors who want to make a difference in the world by studying science, technology, engineering or math (STEM) in college. Requirements for applying include having at least a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale and have financial need. Applications may be found at <u>https://www.edison.com/home/community/edison-scholars.html</u>
- DECEMBER 15 EQUITABLE EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP (\$2,500, \$10,000, \$25,000) – seniors only; regional/state/national competition; recognizes those who have achieved an extraordinary community service accomplishment; criteria also includes academic achievement, leadership, participation in school/community activities and/or the workplace. APPLY EARLY, only the first 10,000 applications will be accepted. To apply, log onto <u>https://learnmore.scholarsapply.org/equitableexcellence/</u>
- DECEMBER 15 BURGER KING SCHOLARS PROGRAM (Varies) For high school seniors who are U.S. residents; have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher; plan to enroll at a two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school. James W. McLamore WHOPPER[™] Scholarship also available to those with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.3; demonstrate active leadership role in community service, athletics, and/or similar co-curricular activity; demonstrate substantial work experience. Only the first 50,000 submitted will be processed. To apply, log onto <u>https://burgerking.scholarsapply.org/</u>
- JANUARY 5 GE REAGAN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP (up to \$40,000) for seniors only who demonstrate at school, at the workplace, and within the community the attributes of leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship; demonstrate strong academic performance; be citizens of the






ATTENDANCE PROCEDURES
