

MARCH 13 - DELTA SIGMA THETA SORORITY, INC. ROLLING HILLS/PV CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP (varies) - seniors only; must be of African-American ancestry; made positive contribution to school/community. Applications may be downloaded from <u>Naviance</u>.

MARCH 15 - CABRILLO CIVIC CLUBS OF CA (\$500) -seniors only; must be of Portuguese descent; minimum weighted GPA of 3.5; participated in three extracurricular activities. To apply, log onto <u>http://www.cabrillocivicclubs.org/scholarship.asp</u>. Applications may also be downloaded from Naviance.

MARCH 15 - ELK'S STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000-\$3,000) - to be eligible to apply, individuals must be a U.S. citizen; be a resident of CA or HI; have a physical impairment, neurological impairment, visual impairment, hearing impairment, and/or speech/language disorder; and be a senior in high school. Funds are to be used for undergraduate work. Selection criteria is based on the following: severity of disability, financial need, GPA, seriousness of purpose and depth of character. ü MARCH 15 - ITALIAN CATHOLIC FEDERATION (up to \$2,500) - seniors

only; must be of Italian ancestry and also Roman Catholic; minimum unweighted GPA of 3.2; participation in extracurricular activities; financial need. To apply log onto <u>https://www.icf.org/scholarships/</u>. Applications may also be downloaded from Naviance.

ü MARCH 16 - CALIFORNIA CREDIT UNION (\$1,000) - seniors only; must have min GPA of 3.0 and evidence of community/school involvement. MARCH 25 - MEGA BANK SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (\$1,000) – for local high school seniors who reside in Los Angeles County and Orange County who plan to attend a U.S. accredited 4–year college or CA community college; must have a min. unweighted GPA of 3.0 and household income at or below CA State low income level; scholarship is open to ALL majors and there is NO ETHNICITY REQUIREMENT. MARCH 25 - ROYAL BUSINESS BANK SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (\$1,000) – for local high school seniors who reside in Los Angeles, Orange or Ventura Counties and plan to attend a U.S. accredited 4–year college or CA community college; must have a min. unweighted GPA of 3.0 and household income at or below CA State low income level; scholarship is open to ALL majors and there is NO ETHNICITY REQUIREMENT. MARCH 25 - SEAN HEFFERNAN MEMORIAL (\$1,000) – graduating senior who shows academic achievement, community service; must include original artwork (includes photography, poem, writing, sculpture, etc.) and an essay on caring. Applications may be downloaded from <u>Naviance</u>.

MARCH 25 - TAIWANESE AMERICAN SCHOLARSHIP FUND (\$2,500) – students must be a high school senior, a U.S. citizen AND a direct blood descendant of a Taiwanese citizen; plan to attend a university in Fall 2019; have an unweighted GPA of 3.0; have a household income at or below the Federal/State/County low income level.
