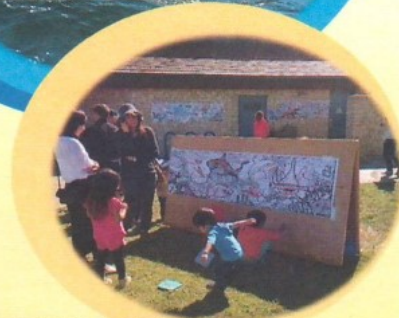

## OUTSIDE OPPORTUNITIES

**ONIZUKA SPACE SCIENCE DAY** will take place on Saturday, **March 7**, at El Camino College. The day is designed for serious-minded science students in grades 5 through 12. The whole event is FREE – including lunch for the first 900 students. This year's featured NASA Astronaut is Mark Vande Hei. He was the Flight Engineer for the Expedition crew that launched the International Space Station in 2017. He logged 168 days in space and ventured outside the space station on four spacewalks. ### **2020 THE LUNDQUIST INSTITUTE'S SUMMER FELLOWSHIP**

**PROGRAM** (previously LA BioMed) provides LA County graduating high school seniors and high school juniors the opportunity to explore careers in the field of biomedical science. Selected students will spend eight weeks assisting their assigned mentors, who are accomplished medical scientists involved in cutting edge biomedical research. Fellowships begin on Monday, June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and continue through Friday, August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Students will work full time and receive a total stipend of \$2,200. **USC LAWRENCE ELLISON INSTITUTE for TRANSFORMATIVE MEDICINE** is a free summer program to foster scientific achievement for rising high school seniors interested in clinical or research oncology. This program attempts to foster scientific education by incorporating hands-on experimentation in a collaborative environment. **Applications will be accepted through April 2, 2020.** The program will begin on June 15<sup>th</sup> and requires the students to commit 6 hours each weekday until July 2<sup>nd</sup>.
