2020 THE LUNDQUIST INSTITUTE'S SUMMER FELLOWSHIP

PROGRAM (previously LA BioMed) provides LA County graduating high school seniors and high school juniors the opportunity to explore careers in the field of biomedical science. Selected students will spend eight weeks assisting their assigned mentors, who are accomplished medical scientists involved in cutting edge biomedical research. Fellowships begin on Monday, June 15th, 2020 and continue through Friday, August 7th, 2020. Students will work full time and receive a total stipend of \$2,200. Students will be selected on the basis of merit. More information and applications can be found online

ONIZUKA SPACE SCIENCE DAY will take place on Saturday, March 7, at El Camino College. The day is designed for serious-minded science students in grades 5 through 12. The whole event is FREE – including lunch for the first 900 students. This year's featured NASA Astronaut is Mark Vande Hei. He was the Flight Engineer for the Expedition crew that launched the International Space Station in 2017. He logged 168 days in space and ventured outside the space station on four spacewalks. MARCH 12 - PVP LION'S CLUB (\$500 - \$1000) – seniors only; consideration will be given to academic achievement (min. GPA of 3.0), service to others, leadership, financial need and a strong desire/plan for further education/professional focus. Applications may be downloaded from <u>Naviance</u>.

MARCH 19 - SILVER SPUR (\$1,000) - for Silver Spur alums; community service and extracurricular activities considered; short essay. Applications may be downloaded from <u>Naviance</u>.

MARCH 20 - ANDREW SAKURA MEMORIAL (\$1,000) - for male seniors only at PVHS; application includes an essay on one of three prompts relating to friendship. Applications may be downloaded from <u>Naviance</u>.
