
<u>Lastly, please do not send your student to campus if they are sick, experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, or are currently under quarantine.</u>

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES and DEADLINES:



- Technique: The level of skill demonstrated in the basic principles/techniques of the arts area.
