- Use even, natural lighting
- Take a vertical photo
- Choose a solid, clean background
- Take a straight-on photo including the student's full head and shoulders
- Leave some space above the student's head
- · Adhere to the school dress code
- · Avoid props and filters
- · Submit a high-resolution color photo
- Save as JPEG
- TIP: Have someone else take the photo! NO selfies!



NO!

- Don't crop too closely around the face
- Don't shoot the whole body. This is a portrait!
- Don't include other people in the photo
- Don't have shadows over your face
- Don't have a distracting background
- Don't take an angled photo. Shoot straight on!

OUTSIDE OPPORTUNITIES

The EVE and GENE BLACK SUMMER MEDICAL CAREER PROGRAM is an opportunity best described as a medical mentor program. Students work under the supervision of a health care educator shadowing various medical professionals (nurse, nutritionist, pharmacist, lab technician, and/or physician) who together provide a range of patient care and services. The program accepts applications from high school students who are current 11th and 12th graders AND born ON or BEFORE 7/1/2005. Online sessions will take place July 5-15 and July 19 -29. 2020 THE LUNDQUIST INSTITUTE'S SUMMER FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM (previously LA BioMed) provides LA County graduating high school seniors and high school juniors the opportunity to explore careers in the field of biomedical science. Selected students will spend eight weeks assisting their assigned mentors, who are accomplished medical scientists involved in cutting edge biomedical research. Fellowships begin on June 14 and continue through August 6. Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the 2021 Summer Fellows Program will continue to be conducted virtually, with an enhanced curriculum of lecture and discussion sessions, followed by small group research projects culminating in a virtual project presentation. - MARCH 4 PVP LION'S CLUB (\$1,000) seniors only; consideration will be given to academic achievement (min. GPA of 3.0), service to others, leadership, financial need and a strong desire/plan for further education/professional focus. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- MARCH 6 PANHELLENIC ALUMNAE SOUTH BAY ASSOCIATION
 (\$1,000) for female seniors only who will be attending a 4 year college or
 university where sororities are established; must demonstrate academic
 excellence, demonstrate character, participation in school/community, and

- MARCH 6 PV JUNIOR WOMEN'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP (\$5,000) seniors only; awarded primarily on financial need with a secondary emphasis on academic achievement, community service and extracurricular activities. To apply log onto https://www.pvjuniors.org/scholarships
- MARCH 9 MARY P. WYATT (\$1,000) PVHS seniors only; min 3.0 GPA; demonstrates financial need; actively helps others. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- MARCH 12 NATIONAL CHARITY LEAGUE (varies) seniors only; awarded based on financial need, academic performance, and extracurricular activities including community service. Scholarship RENEWABLE for each year in college. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- MARCH 12 PEF SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (\$1,500) –seniors only; must be currently enrolled in the PVPUSD and maintained enrollment for two years prior to graduation; need to write a maximum 500 word essay on the following topic "How has PEF funding enhanced students' educational experience?" - MARCH 12 PVP ROTARY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP (\$3,000, \$5,000) seniors only; scholarship, leadership, service, and financial aid are deciding
 factors; will award several scholarships at \$3,000 and one \$5,000 that is

- MARCH 19 PVP COUNCIL OF PTSAs (\$1,250) seniors only; MUST be a PTSA member at least 30 days prior to the deadline and complete an essay of 250-500 words describing the role PTA has played in supporting and enriching your K-12 education. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
