COLLEGE ESSENTIALS TOOLKIT #7 - MARCH 24 from 3:00-4:30 PM: BREAKING DOWN THE COLLEGE SEARCH, A workshop for students presented by Johns Hopkins University. This is highly recommended for the CLASS OF 2022 and other students who are ready to get started on their college search and begin thinking more critically about the application process! Utilizing brainstorming and reflection exercises, you'll learn how to identify what college characteristics are most important for you and develop an application that best demonstrates your strengths and match with an institution. Admissions officers will cover how to research different schools and tips and insights into how to finalize your list of schools to apply to.

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES and DEADLINES

As scholarships become available, they are posted on NAVIANCE. For a complete list, CLICK HERE. To access more information on these scholarships, please log onto NAVIANCE. Click on the COLLEGES tab and then scroll down to SCHOLARSHIPS and MONEY. Click on SCHOLARSHIP LIST. Then select

LOCAL and REGIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS. At this point, choose the scholarship of interest. In many cases, you will be directed to a website for the application. In other instances, you may be able to download the application directly from NAVIANCE.

Please make note of the following **DEADLINES through MARCH 31**:

- **MARCH 18** - *PERRAULT FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP* (\$1,000) - awarded to a senior soccer player, male or female, who has been a member of the PVHS Varsity Soccer Team during their senior year. Criteria includes leadership, commitment to the sport and academic achievement. Preference given to soccer players who have played defensive positions. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- **MARCH 19** - *PVP COUNCIL OF PTSAs* (\$1,250) - seniors only; MUST be a PTSA member at least 30 days prior to the deadline and complete an essay of 250-500 words describing the role PTA has played in supporting and enriching your K-12 education. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- **MARCH 23** - *JACK & ELISA BAGDASAR MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP* (\$500) – awarded to a senior who demonstrates the ability and desire to be a K-12 school teacher. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- **MARCH 24** - *SILVER SPUR* (\$1,000) - for Silver Spur alums; community service and extracurricular activities considered; short essay. Applications may be downloaded from NAVIANCE.
- **MARCH 26** - *CALIFORNIA CREDIT UNION* (\$1,000) - seniors only; must have min GPA of 3.0 and evidence of community/school involvement. To apply log onto <https://www.ccu.com/educators/school-employees/scholarships-grants/1000-college-scholarship-program>
- **MARCH 26** - *DELTA SIGMA THETA SORORITY, INC. LA CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP* (varies) - seniors only; must be of African-American ancestry; have at least at 2.5 GPA (financial need based) or 3.5 (merit-based) on a 4.0 scale; demonstrate extracurricular activity/leadership; show financial need. - **MARCH 26** - *PVHS ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP* (\$500) – PVHS seniors only; short application and an essay not to exceed two pages about contributions you have made to the Sea King Community and your plans to support involvement of PVHS Alumni with PVHS/PV Community. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- **MARCH 31** - *DELTA SIGMA THETA SORORITY, INC. ROLLING HILLS/PV CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP* (varies) - seniors only; must be of African-American ancestry; made positive contribution to school/community. To apply log onto <https://www.rhpvacdst.com/scholarship>
- **MARCH 31** - *PV CHAPTER OF THE LINKS*(varies) – applicants must be a graduating senior and accepted to an accredited university, and have demonstrated a willingness to make a positive contribution to their
