

We are pleased to announce Palos Verdes Peninsula Summer Schools program (PVPSS), under the auspices of the Peninsula Education Foundation, will once again be offering Summer High School for PVPUSD students entering 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade in the fall.

Out of an abundance of caution for the well-being of both the students we serve and our valued teachers, each summer program will have a contingent plan that will allow for a seamless transition between "on campus" instruction and online distance learning should the need arise. Above all else, we strive to ensure that **safety** and **quality of instruction** remain as our top priorities.

SUMMER HIGH SCHOOL (9th - 12th) - will be offered on the Palos Verdes Peninsula High School campus. PVPUSD students attending high school in the fall will have the opportunity to enroll in either an "on campus" or online distance learning program. On campus course enrollment will not exceed 16 students per

course.\* All courses offered provide credit toward high school graduation and meet UC and CSU college entrance requirements through our highly acclaimed WASC accredited program. Students who have met the prerequisite requirements, may enroll in a course for advancement or credit recovery. Highly qualified and experienced PVPUSD teachers will provide three hours of direct instruction and the equivalent of two and one-half hours asynchronous coursework each day which is to be completed off campus and at a time that is most suitable for each student's individual preference. Semester and year-long courses are available in both the on campus and online programs.
