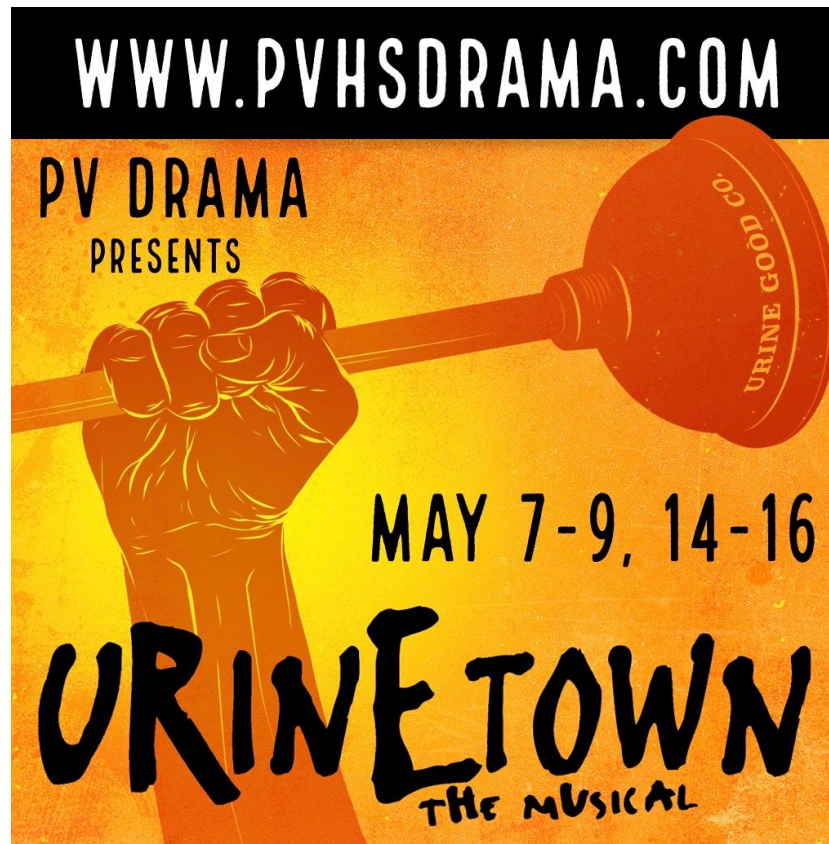

Attention all Juniors and Seniors! Prom is scheduled for May 14th from 7-10pm at the South Coast Botanic Gardens. Prom 2021, an interactive experience at the South Coast Botanical Gardens, will be held on Friday, May 14th from 7:30pm-10:00pm. Seniors are invited to attend our first ever 'Moving Prom' in a group with 75 students whom they may choose. Each group of students will arrive at the Botanical Gardens in intervals of 15 minutes at a pre-designated time. Prom attendees will be guided through the various experiences at the gardens, including music, DJs, pictures, themed-props, beautiful lighting, airbrush tattoos and stilt walkers! All LA County Guidelines will be followed.

Tickets will go on sale on Monday, May 3rd for our Junior-Senior Prom at South Coast Botanic Gardens. - **MAY 1 - SUSAN PAVELKA SCHOLARSHIP FOR JOURNALISTIC EXCELLENCE** (\$500) – for a college-bound senior who has participated and excelled in Palos Verdes High School journalism. Candidates are eligible to apply after fulfilling a minimum of two consecutive years as a leader/writer in one or more of these journalism programs: yearbook, literary magazine, newspaper, podcast or broadcast news. Applicants are judged based on leadership, writing and character along with two written entries publications/broadcasts. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
