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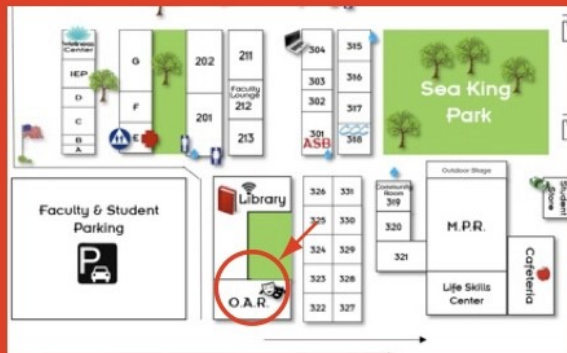

### **SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES and DEADLINES**

As scholarships become available, they are posted on NAVIANCE. For a complete list, [CLICK HERE](#). To access more information on these scholarships, please log onto NAVIANCE. Click on the COLLEGES tab and then scroll down to SCHOLARSHIPS and MONEY. Click on SCHOLARSHIP LIST. Then select LOCAL and REGIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS. At this point, choose the scholarship of interest. In many cases, you will be directed to a website for the application. In other instances, you may be able to download the application directly from NAVIANCE.

Please make note of the following **DEADLINES through APRIL 15:**

- **APRIL 6** - *PVP REPUBLICAN WOMEN, FEDERATED SCHOLARSHIP* (\$1,000) – for graduating high school seniors who subscribe to a Conservative/Republican philosophy; must be a U.S. Citizen; prepare an essay of 500-1000 words on the topic of “What the U.S. Constitution Means to Me”. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- **APRIL 7** - *ILWU - INTERNATIONAL LONGSHORE and WAREHOUSE UNION* (\$500) - Three scholarships will be awarded to PVHS students; application includes an essay on labor leader Harry Bridges. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- **APRIL 7** - *KRYSTAL KAZMARK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP* (\$1,000) – scholarship was created in remembrance of Krystal Kazmark, a PVHS Alumna, whose singing brightened the lives of so many. Applicants must be female in grades 9-12 who are passionate about singing or interested in pursuing vocal education/training. Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded each year. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- **APRIL 8** (deadline extended) - *JACK & ELISA BAGDASAR MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP* (\$500) – awarded to a senior who demonstrates the ability

and desire to be a K-12 school teacher. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.

- **APRIL 9** - *ANDREW SAKURA MEMORIAL* (\$1,000) - for male seniors only at PVHS; application includes an essay on one of three prompts relating to friendship. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- **APRIL 9** - *CORNERSTONE ALUMNAE* (\$500) - honors an outstanding high school senior who is also a Cornerstone graduate. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- **APRIL 9** - *CHUCK CHAMBERS/RUSS URBAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP* (\$500) - seniors only; application and essay on service you have done in school or community. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- **APRIL 9** - *SEAN HEFFERNAN MEMORIAL* (\$1,000) – graduating senior who shows academic achievement, community service; must include original artwork (includes photography, poem, writing, sculpture, etc.) and an essay on caring. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- **APRIL 11** - *AYSO JEFF RICKEL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP* (\$2,000)- awarded to a college-bound senior who has played soccer in, and given volunteer service to the American Youth Soccer Organization (AYSO), Region 10. - **APRIL 15** - *EXCEPTIONAL KIDS PARENT TEACHER ORGANIZATION (EKPTO) SCHOLARSHIP* (\$500) – awards 4 scholarships annually to qualified exceptional senior students. They must have, or had upon graduation, an Individualized Education Plan (IEP). Selection will be based on the financial needs, academic merits, and/or exceptional services.
