#### of the following SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINES through MAY 1:

- APRIL 9 ANDREW SAKURA MEMORIAL (\$1,000) for male seniors only at PVHS; application includes an essay on one of three prompts relating to friendship. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- APRIL 9 CORNERSTONE ALUMNAE (\$500) honors an outstanding high school senior who is also a Cornerstone graduate. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- APRIL 9 CHUCK CHAMBERS/RUSS URBAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$500) - seniors only; application and essay on service you have done in school or community. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- APRIL 9 SEAN HEFFERNAN MEMORIAL (\$1,000) graduating senior who shows academic achievement, community service; must include original artwork (includes photography, poem, writing, sculpture, etc.) and an essay on caring. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- APRIL 11 AYSO JEFF RICKEL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$2,000)awarded to a college-bound senior who has played soccer in, and given volunteer service to the American Youth Soccer Organization (AYSO), Region 10. - APRIL 12 (deadline extended) PVHS ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP (\$500) PVHS seniors only; short application and an essay not to exceed two pages about contributions you have made to the Sea King Community and your plans to support the involvement of PVHS Alumni with PVHS/PV Community. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- APRIL 14 PVP ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS (varies) for seniors only who attend PVPUSD high schools; students need to attend 2 or 4-year colleges in Fall 2021; have contributed to school and community; demonstrate financial need. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- APRIL 15 EXCEPTIONAL KIDS PARENT TEACHER ORGANIZATION (EKPTO) SCHOLARSHIP (\$500) – awards 4 scholarships annually to qualified exceptional senior students. They must have, or had upon graduation, an Individualized Education Plan (IEP). Selection will be based on the financial needs, academic merits, and/or exceptional services. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
- APRIL 16 CALIFORNIA WATER SERVICE GROUP SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (\$2,500 - \$10,000) – for students who live in one of Cal Water's service areas and will be enrolled in full time undergraduate study at a two or four-year college/university. or vocational-technical school may be eligible to apply. Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, participation/leadership in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of goals, and unusual personal or family circumstances. - APRIL 18 VIETNAM VETERANS OF AMERICA SCHOLARSHIP ESSAY PROGRAM (\$1,000) – seniors only; must write an essay 500 – 1,000 words on a Vietnam Era Veteran. More information can be accessed at <u>http://www.vva53.org/</u>
- MAY 1 SUSAN PAVELKA SCHOLARSHIP FOR JOURNALISTIC EXCELLENCE (\$500) – for a college-bound senior who has participated and excelled in Palos Verdes High School journalism. Candidates are eligible to apply after fulfilling a minimum of two consecutive years as a leader/writer in one or more of these journalism programs: yearbook, literary magazine, newspaper, podcast or broadcast news. Applicants are judged based on leadership, writing and character along with two written entries publications/broadcasts. Applications may be downloaded from Naviance.
