COVID Updates

Face Masks:

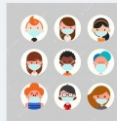

COVID-19 TIPS and TESTING

Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District 2021



My child tested positive for COVID-19, what should I do?

Immediately report the test result to the site administrator. Also, notify your site administrator if your child did attend any afterschool programs and/or youth sports 2 days before their symptoms first appeared.



My child is considered a close contact, what does that mean? Should my child get tested?

A person is considered to have been exposed to a case during the infectious period if a least one of the following criteria are met:

- Being within 6 feet of the infected person for 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period.
- Unmasked exposure

Students with an exposure should test for COVID-19 and report the test results to their site administrator immediately.



Quarantine Requirements

Unvaccinated students must self-quarantine and monitor their symptoms for 10 days from their last contact with the person with COVID-19.

Vaccinated students are recommended to test for COVID-19 but are not required to quarantine.

Testing is available at three sites

Testing app for sign-up will be available on the District website.



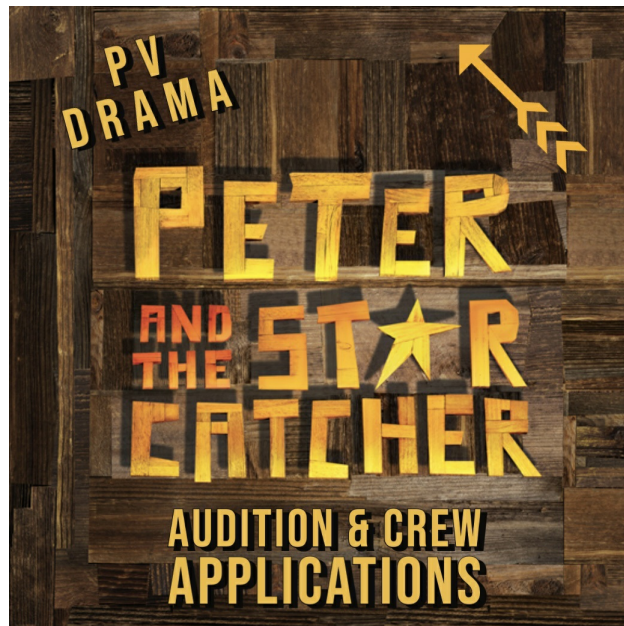
