<u>PVHS COLLEGE KNOWLEDGE SERIES</u> Thursday, October 13th at 6:30 pm (Virtual) – FAFSA Walk-Through

Seniors need to submit the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) to the colleges to which they are applying in order to determine if they are eligible for any financial aid awards. Jessica Medina Kelly, Associate Director of Outreach in the USC Financial Aid Office, will provide step by step guidance on how to complete the FAFSA. She will share tips and answer commonly asked questions about completing the form. SENIOR parents and students are encouraged to create their account and FSA ID (see link below) prior to the presentation so you can log on to the FAFSA and follow along during the presentation. Please note that it typically takes 1-3 days to verify your FSA ID. This program is targeted for parents of seniors. However, it may also be helpful for parents of juniors to attend in order to gain an understanding of the information needed to fill out this form next year.




