- *Rules of the road and resources for safety*

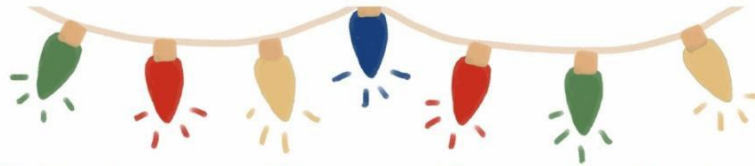

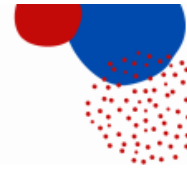
