



**ATTENTION SENIORS.** Congratulations on making it through your first semester of senior year. Some of your colleges may now require that you send them a Mid-Year Transcript. Not all colleges require it. We recommend checking your Common App list or your college student portal to see if a Mid-Year Report is required.

To order mid-year transcripts, please come to the Counseling Office and pick up an orange 'Mid-Year Transcript Request' card, fill it out, make the payment at the student store, and then submit the completed card with the receipt attached to your counselor's box in the counseling office. Your counselor will be submitting mid-year transcripts no sooner than the week of January 18th as soon as transcripts are finalized.


