



Counseling Office Updates

Scheduling for the 2022-2023 School Year

PVHS families will receive scheduling materials in the mail this week for your students to pick their classes for the 2022-2023 school year. Please review the

Please support your student(s) by reviewing these materials with them. The Aeries window will be open for students to enter their course requests until Sunday night, February 20th. Once students have completed inputting their course request, they must submit their Scheduling Worksheet and Four-Year Plan Worksheet to their counselor's box in the Counseling Office. Parent/guardian signature is required on both forms.

OUTSIDE OPPORTUNITIES:

2022 THE LUNDQUIST INSTITUTE'S SUMMER FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM (previously LA BioMed) provides LA County graduating high school seniors and high school juniors the opportunity to explore careers in the field of biomedical science. Selected students will spend eight weeks assisting their assigned mentors, who are accomplished medical scientists involved in cutting edge biomedical research. Fellowships begin on June 13 and continue through August 5. Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the 2022 Summer Fellows Program will continue to be conducted virtually, with the possibility of on-campus positions and stipends. Application deadline is March 15. More information and applications can be found on their WEBSITE.

STUDENT ELECTION WORKER PROGRAM coordinated by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk would like to encourage students of 16 years of age or older to volunteer as a student election worker for the upcoming June 7

Statewide Direct Primary Election. All students who are placed are required to attend two training sessions (one in-person and one online session) prior to their assignment. Participating students will select a 3-day work assignment (one day includes June 7 during FINALS WEEK). Students are assigned to a precinct in close proximity to their home or school. In addition to gaining an invaluable learning experience about the democratic process, students receive \$100 each day they serve as an election worker and an additional \$80 bonus for attending a mandatory training class for a total of \$380.

Any high school student that meets the following requirements may apply:

- ·Must be a U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident AND 16 years of age
- ·Must be attending a public/private secondary institution
- ·Must be in good academic standing with a GPA of 2.5 or greater
- ·Must have teacher AND parental consent


