OUTSIDE OPPORTUNITIES

STUDENT ELECTION WORKER PROGRAM coordinated by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk would like to encourage students of 16 years of age or older to volunteer as a student election worker for the upcoming **June 7 Statewide Direct Primary Election**. All students who are placed are required to attend two training sessions (one in-person and one online session) prior to their assignment. **Participating students will select a 3-day work assignment (one day includes June 7 during FINALS WEEK)**. Students are assigned to a precinct in close proximity to their home or school. In addition to gaining an invaluable learning experience about the democratic process, students receive \$100 each day they serve as an election worker and an additional \$80 bonus for attending a mandatory training class for a total of \$380. Any high school student that meets the following requirements may apply:

- Must be a U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident AND 16 years of age
- Must be attending a public/private secondary institution
- Must be in good academic standing with a GPA of 2.5 or greater
- Must have teacher AND parental consent

Deadline to apply has been extended to Friday, March 11. Applications are submitted online and must be requested from Teresa Hoffman at hoffmant@pvpusd.net

INTERESTED IN THE NAVAL ACADEMY? These summer programs from the U.S. Naval Academy are for current high school juniors and is a week-long in June. **Applications are open** now and will **close March 31, 2022**. You can find more information [HERE](#).

CLASS OF 2023 & 2024: MEDICAL SCHOLARS PROGRAM: The Osborne Head and Neck Foundation has opened enrollment to their [Medical Scholars Program](#), a 3-week immersive hybrid mentoring and educational course for

aspiring physicians. This highly sought-after program is a **rare opportunity for high school students to learn from leaders in medicine** and gain hands-on experience prior to college in:

- Medical school application and interview preparation
- Operating room and clinical shadowing
- Medical ethics, patient interviewing
- Hands-on experiences with suturing, knot tying, and microscopy labs

MARCH 25 - **PVHS ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP** (\$500) – PVHS seniors only; short application and an essay not to exceed two pages about contributions you have made to the Sea King Community and your plans to support involvement of PVHS Alumni with PVHS/PV Community.

MARCH 26 – **PEF SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP** (\$1,500) – for high school seniors who are continuing their education at the post-secondary level. Applicants must be enrolled in the PVPUSD and maintained enrollment for two years prior to graduation. An essay on "How has PEF funding enhanced your personal educational experience?" (500 word maximum) must be submitted with your application.

MARCH 28 - **KIWANIS CLUB** (\$500; \$1,000) – high school seniors only; given to students to have shown special heart, academic merit, service and financial need. Applicants may apply for the merit/leadership option OR merit/leadership/financial aid.

MARCH 31 – **CAL WATER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM** (\$2,500-\$10,000) - scholarship program to assist students residing within Cal Water's service areas who plan to continue their education in college/vocational school programs.

MARCH 31 – **RH/PV ALUMNAE CHAPTER OF DELTA SIGMA THETA SORORITY SCHOLARSHIP** - for seniors who are of African-American ancestry and made a positive contribution to school/community.

MARCH 31 – [PALOS VERDES PENINSULA ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS SCHOLARSHIP](#) – for seniors only who attend PVPUSD high schools; students need to attend 2 or 4-year colleges in fall 2022; have contributed to school and community; demonstrate financial need.

MARCH 31 – [PALOS VERDES CHAPTER OF THE LINKS SCHOLARSHIP](#) - must be graduating seniors of African-American or of African descent and be accepted into an accredited 2 or 4-year college/university. These scholarships are based on the students' academic achievement, community service, extra-curricular activities, recommendations and financial need.

APRIL 1 – [SOUTH BAY JAPANESE AMERICAN CITIZEN LEAGUE](#) (Varies) – Scholarships are open to all students of Japanese American ancestry residing in the South Bay JACL Chapter area and a member of the JACL. Students are required to fill out only one application for various scholarships offered

APRIL 3 – [PANHELLENIC HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP](#) (varies) - awarded to female graduates of high schools in the South Bay who plan to attend a four-year institution where sororities are established; must have unweighted 3.5 GPA or higher. Will be judged on academic excellence, character, participation in school and community/cultural activities, and financial need.

APRIL 5 – [PVP REPUBLICAN WOMEN FEDERATED SCHOLARSHIP](#) (\$1,000) - must be a graduating high school senior; subscribe to a Conservative/Republican philosophy; be U.S. citizen; prepare a typewritten essay of 500 - 1000 words entitled "What is the Meaning of the U.S. Constitution in the Era of Covid-19."

APRIL 6 – [SILVER SPUR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PTA SCHOLARSHIP](#) (\$1,000) - for Silver Spur alums; community service and extracurricular activities considered; short essay.

APRIL 8 - [CALIFORNIA CREDIT UNION](#) (\$1,000) – graduating high school seniors enrolling in a two or four-year college; must have min GPA of 3.0, community/school involvement.

APRIL 10 – [VIETNAM VETERANS SCHOLARSHIP ESSAY](#) (\$1,000) – for seniors; must interview and write an essay on a Vietnam Era Veteran, including a brief biography of the veteran and the most important things you learned from your interview.

APRIL 15 – [BETH MURANDA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP](#) (\$500) – awards 5 scholarships annually to seniors graduating high school in the Southwest SELPA Area with an active IEP or 504 plan. Students must be planning to continue their education. Selection will be based on the student's financial needs, academic merits, and/or exceptional community services.

APRIL 15 – [SUSAN PAVELKA SCHOLARSHIP FOR JOURNALISTIC EXCELLENCE](#) (\$500) - for a college-bound senior who has participated and excelled in PVHS journalism. Candidates are eligible to apply after fulfilling a minimum of two consecutive years as a leader/writer in one or more of these journalism programs: yearbook, literary magazine, newspaper, podcast or broadcast news.
