Library Hours Update

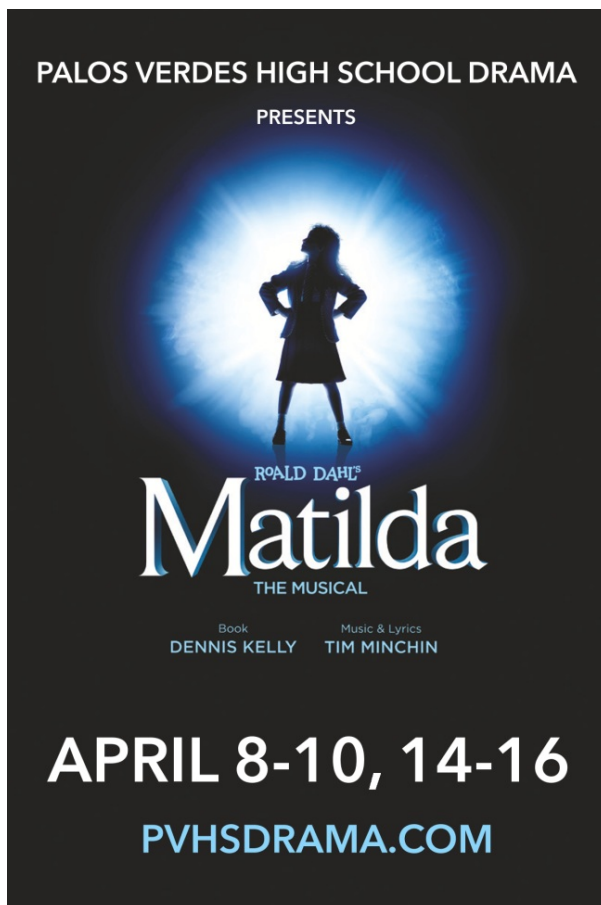

OUTSIDE OPPORTUNITIES

STUDENT ELECTION WORKER PROGRAM coordinated by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk would like to encourage students of 16 years of age or older to volunteer as a student election worker for the upcoming **June 7 Statewide Direct Primary Election**. All students who are placed are required to attend two training sessions (one in-person and one online session) prior to their assignment. **Participating students will select a 3-day work assignment (one day includes June 7 during FINALS WEEK)**. Students are assigned to a precinct in close proximity to their home or school. In addition to gaining an invaluable learning experience about the democratic process, students receive \$100 each day they serve as an election worker and an additional \$80 bonus for attending a mandatory training class for a total of \$380. Any high school student that meets the following requirements may apply:

- Must be a U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident AND 16 years of age
- Must be attending a public/private secondary institution
- Must be in good academic standing with a GPA of 2.5 or greater
- Must have teacher AND parental consent

Deadline to apply has been extended indefinitely. Applications are submitted online and must be requested from Teresa Hoffman at hoffmant@pvpusd.net

APRIL 14 (extended deadline) – [PVP ROTARY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP](#) (\$2,000) - seniors only; scholarship, leadership, service, and financial aid are deciding factors; will award multiple scholarships.

APRIL 15 – [BETH MURAYDA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP](#) (\$500) – awards 5 scholarships annually to seniors graduating high school in the Southwest SELPA Area with an active IEP or 504 plan. Students must be planning to continue their education. Selection will be based on the student's financial needs, academic merits, and/or exceptional community services.

APRIL 15 – [SUSAN PAVELKA SCHOLARSHIP FOR JOURNALISTIC EXCELLENCE](#) (\$500) - for a college-bound senior who has participated and excelled in PVHS journalism. Candidates are eligible to apply after fulfilling a minimum of two consecutive years as a leader/writer in one or more of these journalism programs: yearbook, literary magazine, newspaper, podcast or broadcast news.


