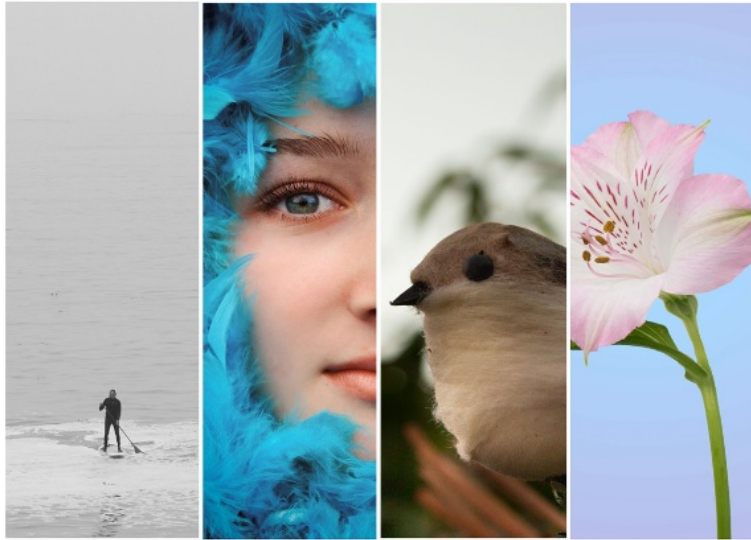

INFORMATION REGARDING THE COUNCIL

- Members of the Council will work directly with staff in Rep. Lieu's office to collaborate on key issues
- There are 8 scheduled meetings with staff per year and students will need to attend 6 of the 8 meetings in order to remain in good standing
- Students will be appointed to a one-year term
 - If eligible, students can serve on the council for a maximum of two years
- No more than one student per high school will be selected

- Applicants must be a high school student in CA-33
- An official high school transcript (freshmen should also submit 8th grade transcripts)
- Two letters of recommendation (not from relatives)
- One-page essay explaining why you wish to be a member of the Council

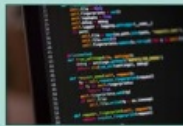
