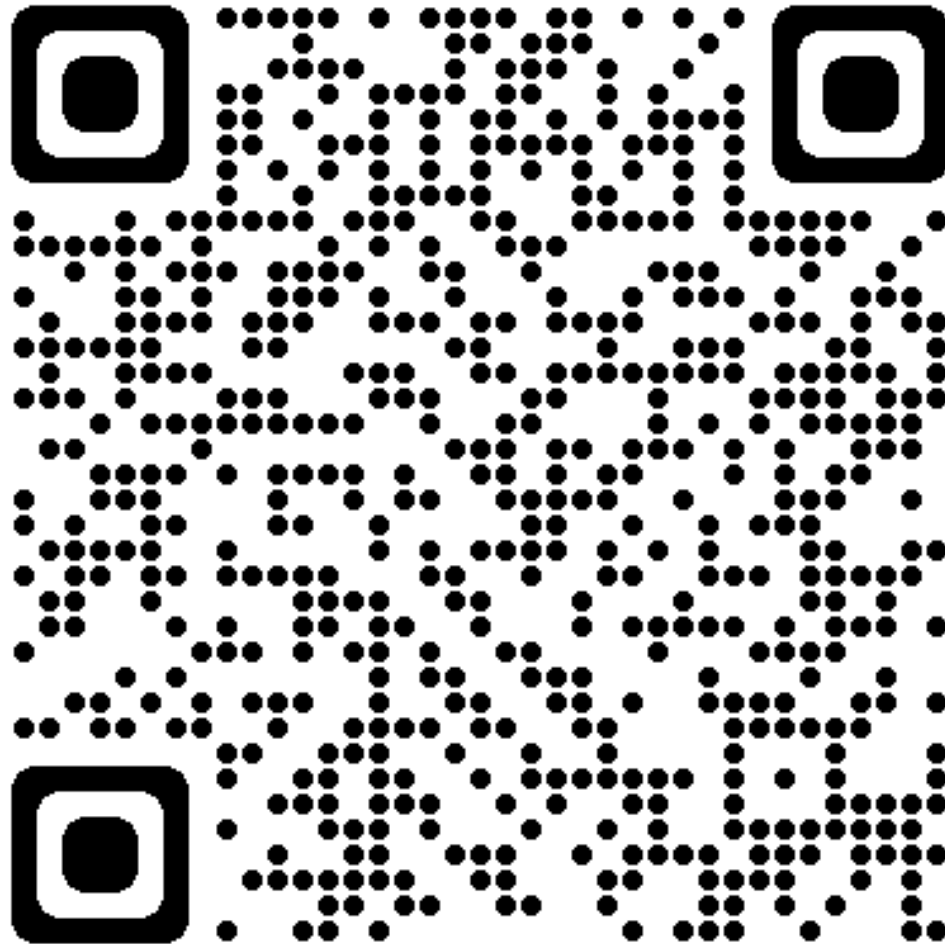

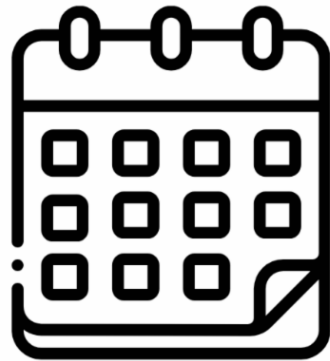

FINANCIAL AID NIGHT: Understanding Financial Aid will be presented VIRTUALLY on Tuesday, **October 24, at 6:30 pm** by Kimberly Guerrero, Associate Director, Outreach at USC Financial Aid Office. This is essential information for our seniors/juniors and their families. But all grade levels are encouraged to attend to attain a better understanding of financial aid. Four main topics relating to financial aid for college will be discussed: types of financial aid that are available, how schools determine eligibility, how to apply, and how to find/apply to merit scholarships. Additionally, USC will briefly address some of the changes that the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) are undergoing. Registration information will be coming soon. A FAFSA Walk-Through will take place in December/January once the revised FAFSA becomes available to the Class of 2024.

OCTOBER 31 – [VFW VOICE OF DEMOCRACY ESSAY CONTEST](#) (up to \$35,000) - audio-essay program provides high school students with the unique opportunity to express themselves in regard to a democratic and patriotic-themed recorded essay. To apply, record your original 3–5-minute (+ or – 5 second max.) audio essay on a flash drive, or another electronic device.

NOVEMBER 13 - [ELKS CLUB MVS FOUNDATION](#) (up to \$50,000) – seniors only; local/district/state/national competition; applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, community service, and financial need. Large emphasis on academics.

JANUARY 23 - [EDISON SCHOLARS](#) (\$50,000) - for seniors who want to make a difference in the world by studying science, technology, engineering or math (STEM) in college. Requirements for applying include having at least a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale and show financial need.

FEBRUARY 5 - ELK'S LEGACY AWARD (\$4,000) – seniors only; any child/grandchild of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2020 is eligible to apply. Candidates who qualify are judged on knowledge, charity, community service, and integrity

MARCH 22 –SUSAN PAVELKA SCHOLARSHIP FOR JOURNALISTIC EXCELLENCE (\$500)- for a college-bound senior who has participated and excelled in PVHS journalism. Candidates are eligible to apply after fulfilling a minimum of two consecutive years as a leader/writer in one or more of these journalism programs: yearbook, literary magazine, newspaper, podcast or broadcast news.
