



FINANCIAL AID NIGHT: Understanding Financial Aid will be presented VIRTUALLY on Tuesday, October 24, at 6:30 pm by Kimberly Guerrero, Associate Director, Outreach at USC Financial Aid Office. This is essential information for our seniors/juniors and their families. But all grade levels are encouraged to attend to attain a better understanding of financial aid.

Four main topics relating to financial aid for college will be discussed: types of financial aid that are available, how schools determine eligibility, how to apply, and how to find/apply to merit scholarships. Additionally, USC will briefly address some of the changes that the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) are undergoing. Here is the registration link for zoom webinar.

A FAFSA Walk-Through will take place in December/January once the revised FAFSA becomes available to the Class of 2024.

STUDENT ELECTION WORKER PROGRAM coordinated by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk would like to encourage students of 16 years of age or

older to volunteer as a student election worker for the upcoming March 5 Presidential Primary Election. All students who are placed are required to attend two training sessions (one in-person and one online session) prior to their assignment. All students who are placed will be given the following 3-day assignment:

- · Saturday, March 2: 9 am 8 pm
- · Sunday, March 2: 9 am 8 pm
- · Tuesday, March 5: 6 am 9 pm

Students are assigned to a precinct in close proximity to their home or school. Participating students earn a stipend up to \$380 (\$480 if bilingual) along with hands on experience with the democratic process. Any high school student that meets the following requirements may apply:

- · Must be a U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident AND 16 years of age
- · Must be attending a public/private secondary institution
- \cdot Must be in good academic standing with a GPA of 2.5 or greater
- · Must have teacher AND parental consent
- · Must be fully vaccinated from COVID 19 and prov Participating students earn a stipend up to \$380 (\$480 if bilingual). All ide proof of vaccination

Priority registration deadline is **October 27.** They will be placing students on a first come, first serve basis. Applications are submitted online and must be requested from Teresa Hoffman at hoffmant@pvpusd.net.

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES and DEADLINES:

LOS SERENOS DE POINT VICENTE JUNIOR DOCENTS PROGRAM is

open to local high school students. The program is designed to complement the existing educational and support activities including museum tours, hikes support, whale wagon duty and special event participation. If you are interested in becoming a Junior Docent, learn more about the program and how to apply **HERE**. Applications are accepted until December 31; it is best to apply early as positions fill up quickly.

OCTOBER 31 – <u>VFW VOICE OF DEMOCRACY ESSAY CONTEST</u> (up to \$35,000) - audio-essay program provides high school students with the unique opportunity to express themselves in regard to a democratic and patriotic-themed recorded essay. To apply, record your original 3–5-minute (+ or – 5 second max.) audio essay on a flash drive, or another electronic device.

NOVEMBER 13 - **ELKS CLUB MVS FOUNDATION** (up to \$50,000) – seniors only; local/district/state/national competition; applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, community service, and financial need. Large emphasis on academics.

JANUARY 23 - **EDISON SCHOLARS** (\$50,000) - for seniors who want to make a difference in the world by studying science, technology, engineering or math (STEM) in college. Requirements for applying include having at least a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale and show financial need.

FEBRUARY 5 - ELK'S LEGACY AWARD (\$4,000) – seniors only; any child/grandchild of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2020, is eligible to apply. Candidates who qualify are judged on knowledge, charity, community service, and integrity.

MARCH 22 -SUSAN PAVELKA SCHOLARSHIP FOR JOUIRNALISTIC

EXECELLENCE (\$500) - for a college-bound senior who has participated and excelled in PVHS journalism. Candidates are eligible to apply after fulfilling a minimum of two consecutive years as a leader/writer in one or more of these journalism programs: yearbook, literary magazine, newspaper, podcast or broadcast news.
