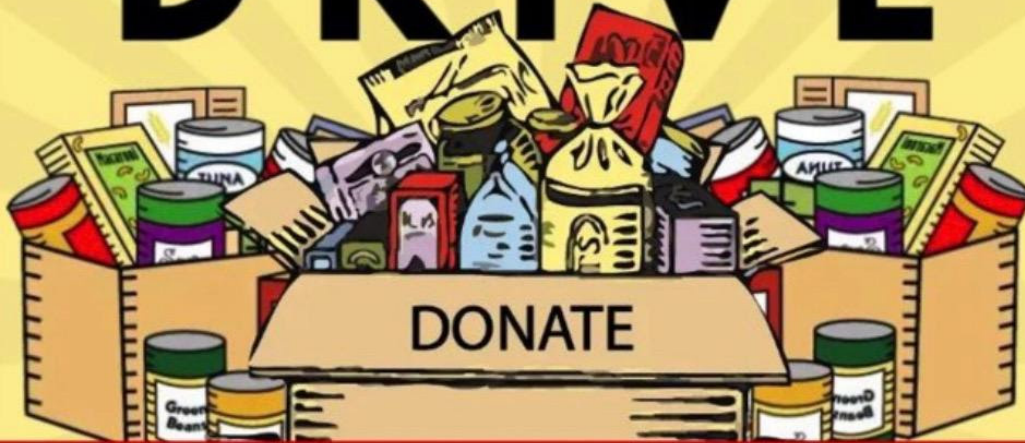

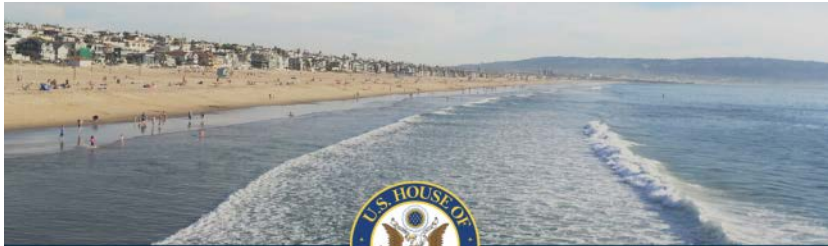


ARTWORK SUBMISSION

OTHER UPCOMING CCC EVENTS

OUT OF STATE COLLEGE FAIR: Options and Opportunities will take place on Thursday, October 19, from 6:30 pm – 7:30 pm in Sea King Center (gym). All PVHS students/parents are welcome! College Reps will introduce their institutions followed by a traditional college fair.

FINANCIAL AID NIGHT: Understanding Financial Aid will be presented VIRTUALLY on Tuesday, October 24, at 6:30 pm by Kimberly Guerrero, Associate Director, Outreach at USC Financial Aid Office. This is essential information for our seniors/juniors and their families. But all grade levels are encouraged to attend to attain a better understanding of financial aid. Four main topics relating to financial aid for college will be discussed: types of financial aid that are available, how schools determine eligibility, how to apply, and how to find/apply to merit scholarships. Additionally, USC will briefly address some of the changes that the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) are undergoing. Registration information will be coming soon. Candidates are eligible to apply after fulfilling a minimum of two consecutive years as a leader/writer in one or more of these journalism programs: yearbook, literary magazine, newspaper, podcast or broadcast news.

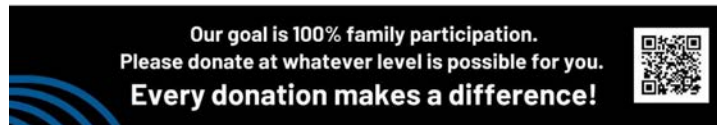
