Strategies for aiding your student in managing stress:

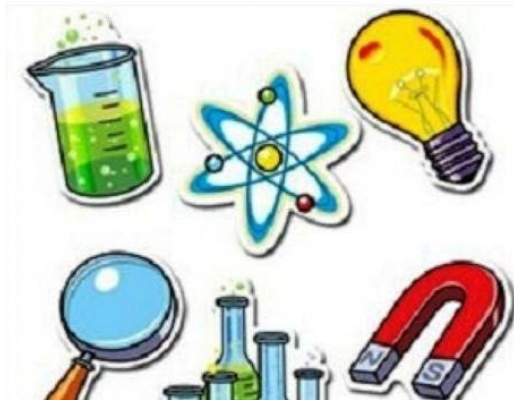
- Provide balanced meals and adequate nutrition

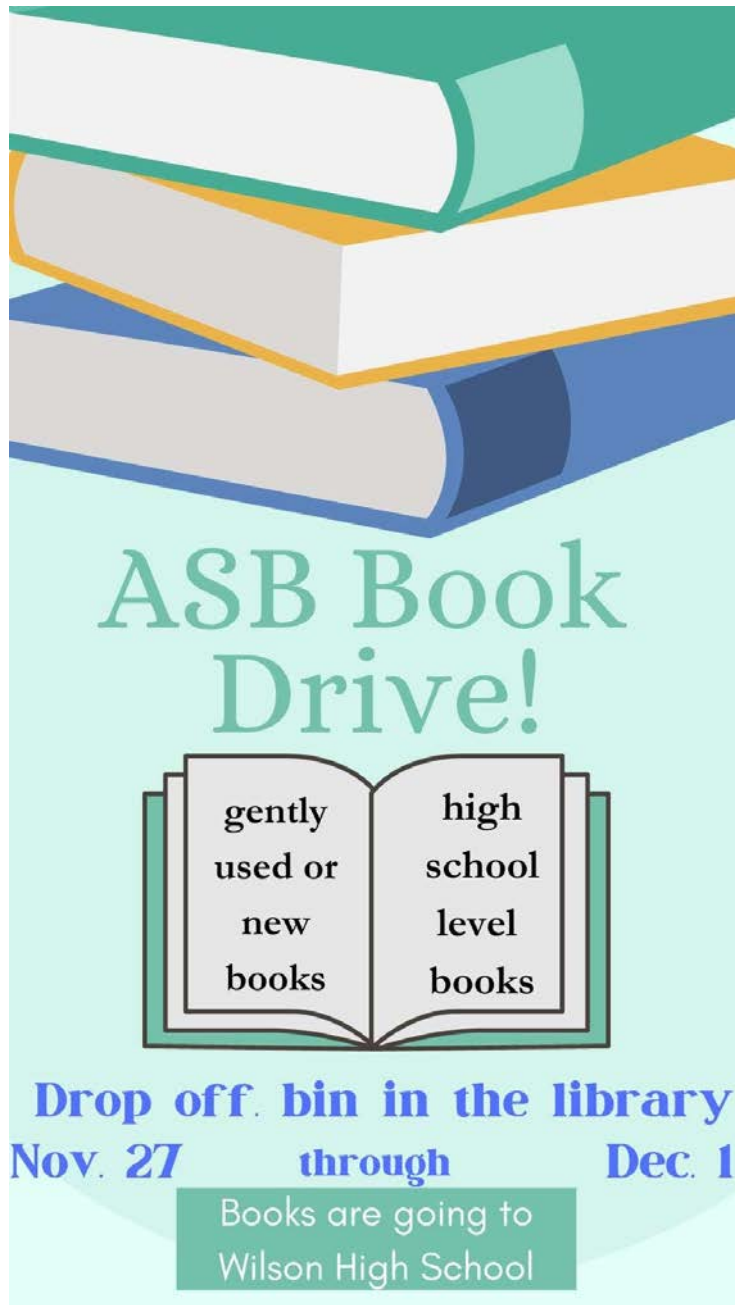

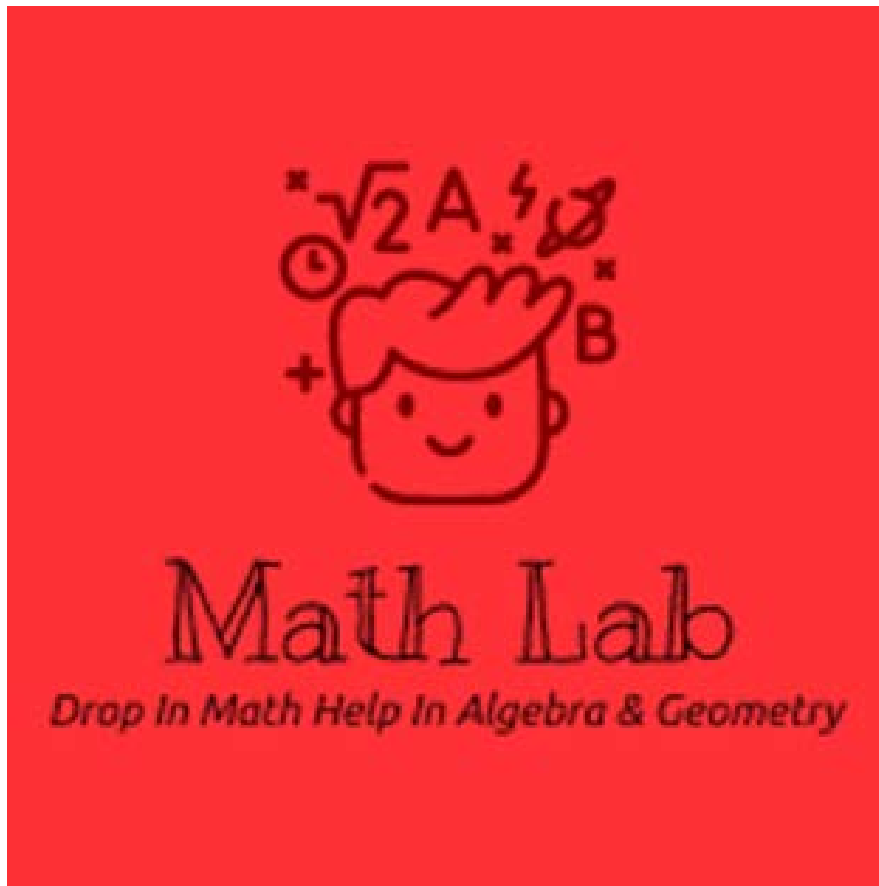

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR SENIORS/PARENTS OF SENIORS ONLY:** The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) will be available by December 31, 2023. Review this important information on the [Launch of the 2024-2025 FAFSA Form](#). Watch [Preparing for the FAFSA](#) Form playlist to understand what information and documents you'll need to fill out the FAFSA form.

Even though the FAFSA is not yet available to complete, you can **Create your FSA ID now.** The FSA ID must be obtained before starting the FAFSA. **CLICK HERE** to create an FSA ID. **Find out if your parent(s) will need to be contributors** (contribute their info on your FAFSA form). If your parent(s) will need to contribute to your form, make sure EACH contributor **creates their own FSA ID.**

The College and Career Center is planning to have a FAFSA Walk Through in January. The date is TBD.

### **SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES and DEADLINES:**

**LOS SERENOS DE POINT VICENTE JUNIOR DOCENTS PROGRAM** is open to local high school students. The program is designed to complement the existing educational and support activities including museum tours, hikes support, whale wagon duty and special event participation. If you are interested in becoming a Junior Docent, learn more about the program and how to apply **HERE**. Applications are accepted until December 31; it is best to apply early as positions fill up quickly.

**Click on the name of the scholarship in order to access the application and further information on the scholarship.**

**DECEMBER 31 - AYSO JEFF RICKEL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$2,000)** - awarded to a college-bound senior who has played soccer in, and given volunteer service to the American Youth Soccer Organization (AYSO), Region 10. Applicant must demonstrate an understanding of the importance of good sportsmanship.

**JANUARY 4 - GE REAGAN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP (up to \$40,000)** – for seniors only who demonstrate at school, at the workplace, and within the community the attributes of leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship; demonstrate strong academic performance; be citizens of the United States.

**JANUARY 23 - EDISON SCHOLARS (\$50,000)** - for seniors who want to make a difference in the world by studying science, technology, engineering or math (STEM) in college. Requirements for applying

include having at least a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale and show financial need.

**FEBRUARY 5 - ELK'S LEGACY AWARD (\$4,000)** – seniors only; any child/grandchild of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2020, is eligible to apply. Candidates who qualify are judged on knowledge, charity, community service, and integrity.

**FEBRUARY 28 – LOS ANGELES MILITARY CHARITABLE FUND SCHOLARSHIP (Varies)** – seniors only; must be a child of an active, retired service member or current or retired Dept. of Defense employee; awarded on academic performance, extracurricular activities, demonstrated leadership, and applicant's character.

**FEBRUARY 29 – MARY P. WYATT SCHOLARSHIP (\$865)** – PVHS seniors only; min 3.0 GPA; demonstrates financial need; actively helps others.

**MARCH 1 – SONS OF ITALY SCHOLARSHIP (\$500 - \$5,000)** – seniors only; must be wholly or partially of Italian Descent; selection based on scholastic record, activities evidencing leadership, financial need, written personal goals statement, essay of Italian Origin, and letters of recommendation.

**MARCH 7 – PERRAULT FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP (\$930)** - awarded to a senior, male or female, who has been a member of the PVHS Varsity Soccer Team during their senior year. Criteria includes leadership, commitment to the sport and academic achievement. Preference given to soccer players who have played defensive positions.

**MARCH 20 – PV PENINSULA LIONS CLUB (\$500 - \$1,000)** - seniors only; consideration will be given to academic achievement (min. GPA of 3.0), service to others, leadership, financial need and a strong desire/plan for further education/professional focus.

**MARCH 22 – SUSAN PAVELKA SCHOLARSHIP FOR JOURNALISTIC EXCELLENCE (\$500)** - for a college-bound senior who has participated and excelled in PVHS journalism. Candidates are eligible to apply after fulfilling a minimum of two consecutive years as a leader/writer in one or more of these journalism programs: yearbook, literary magazine, newspaper, podcast or broadcast news.

**APRIL 1 – SOUTH BAY JAPANESE AMERICAN CITIZEN LEAGUE**

**(Varies) – Scholarships are open to all high school seniors of Japanese American ancestry residing in the South Bay JACL Chapter area and a member of the JACL. Students are required to fill out only one application for the scholarships listed below. The committee will select the recipients for each of the scholarships based upon the requirements:**

- **Kiichi Egashira Memorial Scholarship - for students pursuing a bachelor's degree in physical and biological sciences, engineering/mathematics.**
- **Janice Kobata Zoeger Memorial Scholarship - for students in pursuit of a bachelor's in any field of study relating to biological sciences, foreign and/or ancient language or business.**
- **Ernest K. Tsujimoto Memorial Scholarship - for students in pursuit of an undergraduate degree majoring in the STEM fields.**
- **Gardena Valley Japanese American Citizens League Scholarship - for students pursuing a bachelor's degree in any field of study.**
- **David & Lily Nakatani Scholarships - for high school seniors planning to attend a college or university in pursuit of a bachelor's degree majoring in the STEM fields: Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math**

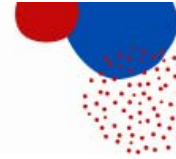
