SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES and DEADLINES:

SENIORS...we are at the height of scholarship season for our Local Community Scholarships, Take advantage of these scholarship because soon they will be gone! Please make note of the following <u>DEADLINES through APRIL noted in</u> **RED**. Click on the name of the scholarship for further information and to apply.

APRIL 4 – PVP REPUBLICAN WOMEN, FEDERATED SCHOLARSHIP

(\$1500) - must be a graduating high school senior; subscribe to a Conservative/Republican philosophy; be U.S. citizen; prepare a typewritten essay of 500 - 1000 words entitled "What is the Meaning of the U.S. Constitution in the Era of Covid-19."

APRIL 5 – SILVER SPUR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PTA

SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000) - for Silver Spur alums who spent at least three years at Silver Spur, including fifth grade. Criteria for consideration will include: 3.0

GPA and above; letter of recommendation; list and description of community service and volunteering, and extra-curricular activities; personal essay.

APRIL 6 - SEAN HEFFERNAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000) graduating senior who shows academic achievement, community service; must include original artwork (includes photography, poem, writing, sculpture, etc.) and an essay on caring.

APRIL 7 - PVHS ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP (\$500) - PVHS seniors only; short application and an essay not to exceed two pages about contributions you have made to the Sea King Community and your plans to support involvement of PVHS Alumni with PVHS/PV Community.

APRIL 7 – KRYSTAL KAZMARK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000) - This scholarship was created in remembrance of Krystal Kazmark, a PVHS Alumna, whose singing brightened the lives of so many. Applicants must be female in grades 9-12 who are passionate about singing or interested in pursuing vocal education/training. Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded each year.

APRIL 13 – PALOS VERDES PENINSULA ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS SCHOLARSHIP – for seniors only who attend PVPUSD high schools; students need to attend 2 or 4-year colleges in fall 2023; have contributed to school and community.

APRIL 15 – <u>BETH MURAIDA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP</u> (\$500) - awards multiple scholarships annually to seniors graduating high school in the Southwest SELPA Area with an active IEP or 504 plan. Students must be planning to continue their education. Selection will be based on the student's financial needs, academic merits, and/or exceptional community services.






