from multiple angles and your written blurb. (Make sure YOU are in at least one of the photos with your creation!)



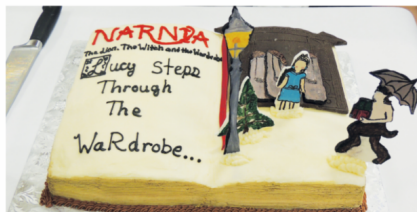

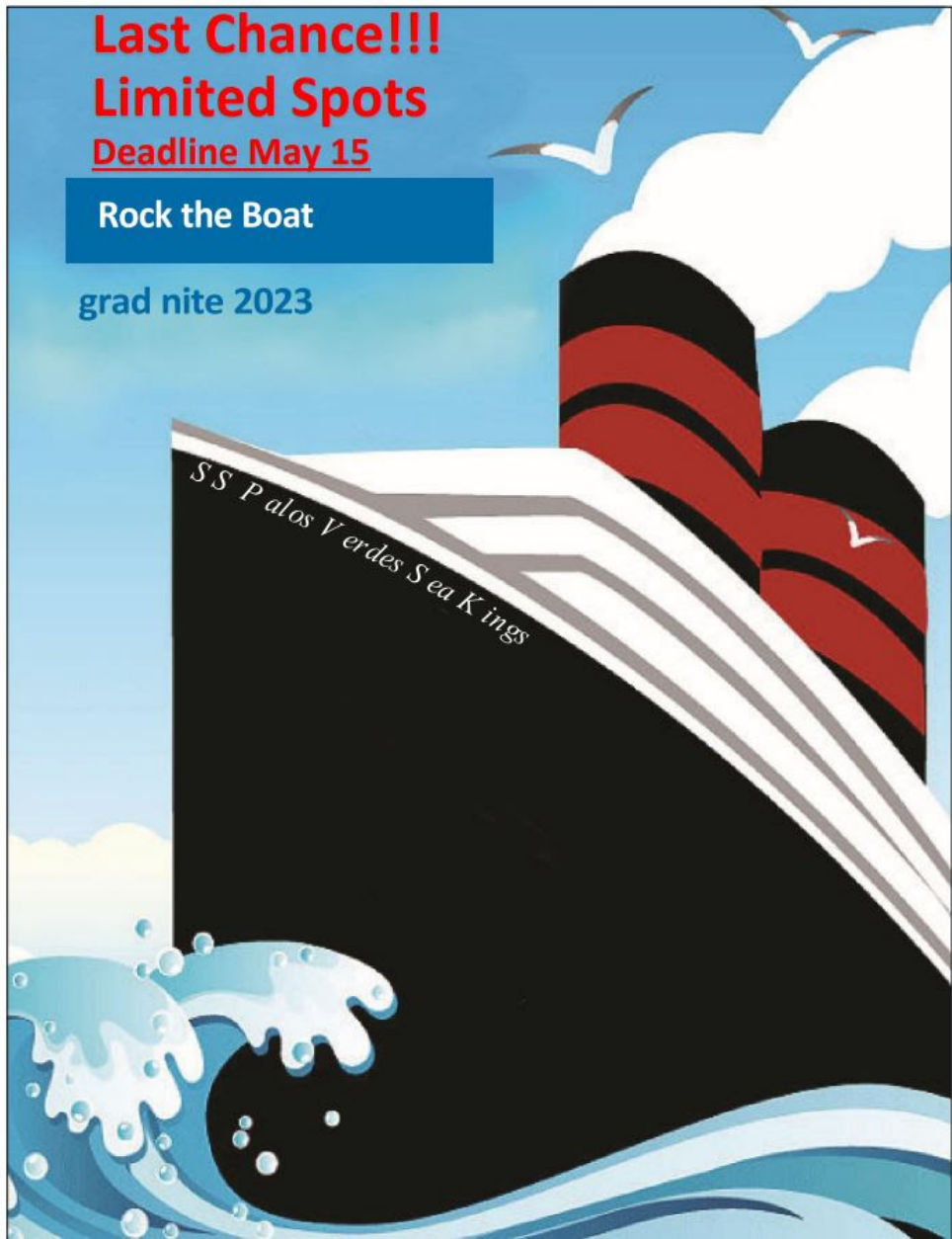
A PLACE FOR SUPPORT

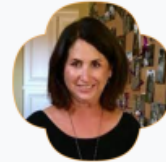
