## A PLACE FOR SUPPORT

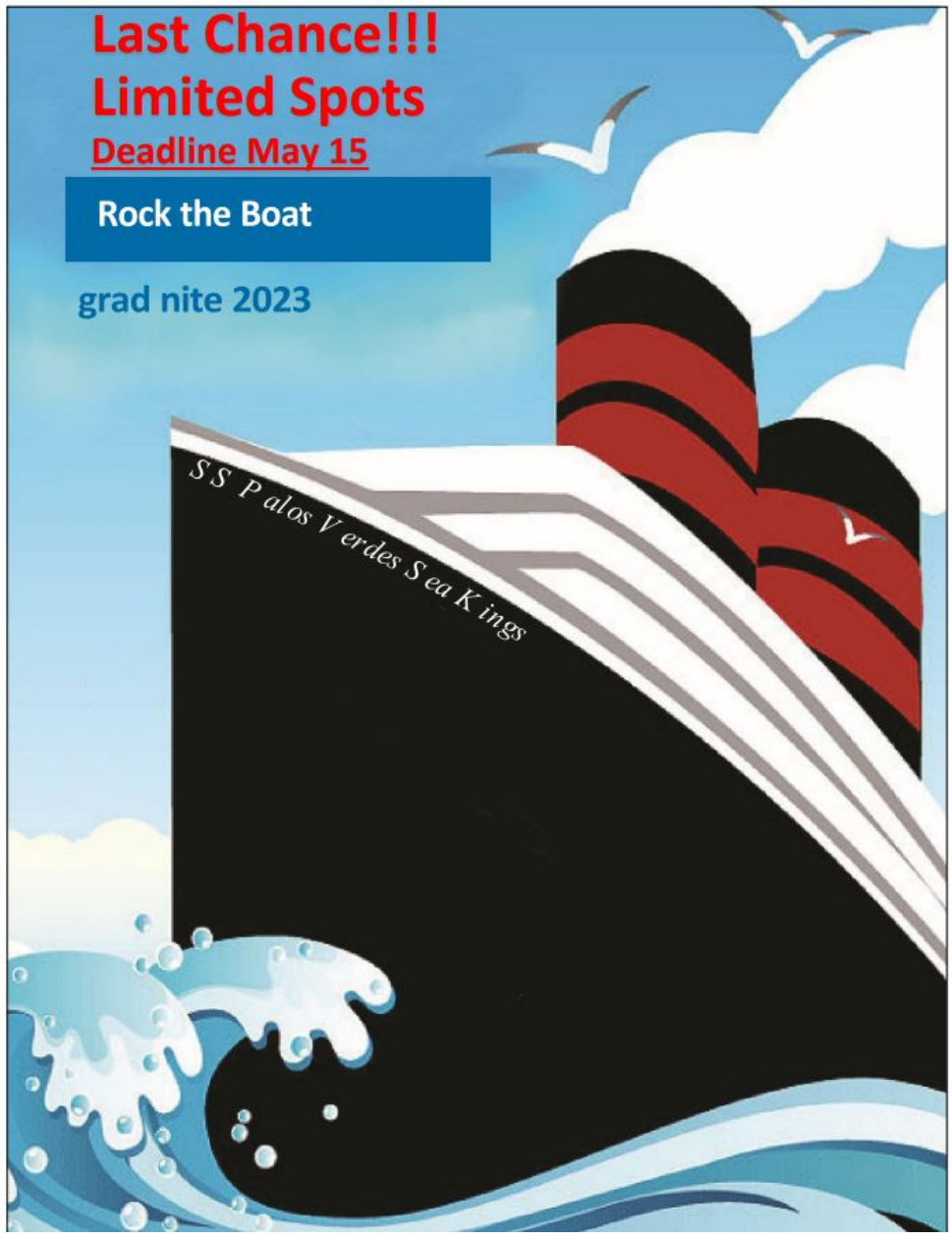

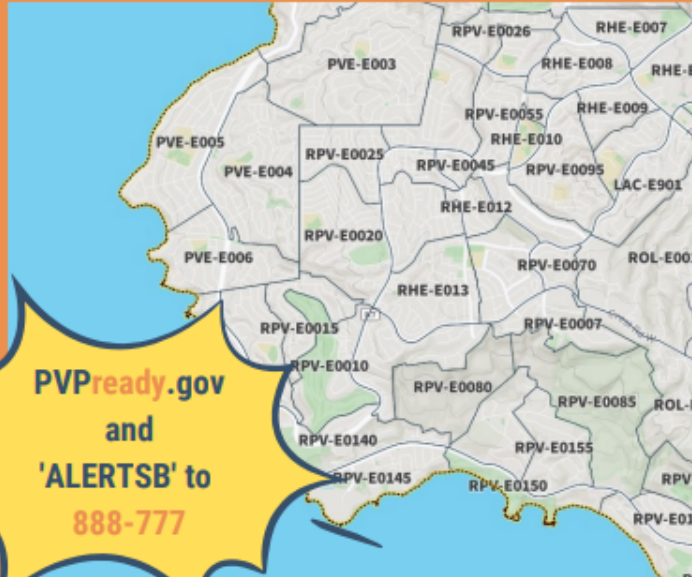

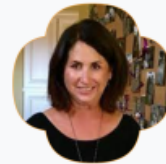
