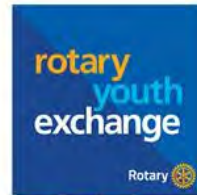

- **OCTOBER 31 – VFW VOICE OF DEMOCRACY ESSAY CONTEST** (up to \$35,000) - audio-essay program provides high school students with the unique opportunity to express themselves in regard to a democratic and patriotic-themed recorded essay. To apply, record your original 3–5-minute (+ or – 5 second max.) audio essay on a flash drive, or another electronic device.
- **NOVEMBER 13 - ELKS CLUB MVS FOUNDATION** (up to \$50,000) – seniors only; local/district/state/national competition; applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, community service, and financial need. Large emphasis on academics.

Early Action/Decision: September 22, 2023

Regular Decision/Alternative Plans: November 3, 2023

Be sure you have locked in these due dates depending on your college application or other alternative plans. If you are applying to any schools with an early action or plan to apply early decision, all components of your senior checklist must be completed and turned in to your counselor's box by Friday, September 22! Note this is a minimum day!

If you are applying only regular decision, to UCs & Cal States only, or have other plans for after graduation, all components of your senior checklist must be completed and turned in to your counselor's box by Friday, November 3!

See your counselor with any questions you may have.

Important Dates:

The last day to drop/level down in a class with no impact to your transcript is Friday, **October 6. Level changes will be based on space availability and the ability to work in your schedule. Any changes after October 6 will result in a "W" (Withdraw) on your transcript.**

2024 United States Senate Youth Program

I am pleased to announce the 2024 United States Senate Youth Program (USSYP). All public and private high schools in the state are invited to nominate up to two outstanding juniors or seniors who are interested in pursuing careers in public service to participate in this educational program coordinated by the California Department of Education (CDE).

Two student delegates from each state will be selected to attend this unique educational experience. The 62nd Annual Washington Week is to be held in person, for the first time since the pandemic, in Washington, D.C., March 2–9, 2024. Student delegates will partake in a comprehensive, interactive leadership program, and each will receive a \$10,000 college scholarship.

To apply, students must be nominated by their high school principal and currently serve in an elected or appointed leadership capacity in a student government, civic, or educational organization for the entire 2023–24 school year. In addition, nominated students must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents, be currently enrolled in a California public or private secondary school, and live in California for the entire academic year. Four finalists, consisting of two delegates and a first and second alternate, will be selected by the CDE to be California's USSYP representatives.

The application and scholarship information for the 2024 USSYP are available on the CDE USSYP web page at <https://www.cde.ca.gov/eo/in/us/>. The deadline to apply is Monday, October 9, 2023.
